3. Late entries may be accepted on the day of check-in at the discretion of the Cook-Off Chairman.

BBQ COOK-OFF RULES & INFORMATION

1. The “Junior BBQ Cook Off Contest” will take place Saturday, August 29, 2026. This contest is for children the age 7 – 12 years. All contestants must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
2. Entry fee will be \$20 per child. The deadline for entries will be 11:00 AM, August 28, 2026. Online entries include a \$5.00 credit card fee. All fees are non-refundable. All entrants must complete a Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement. The agreement will be found online and must be turned in at check-in.
3. Entrees will provide their own pit to cook on.
4. Fayette County Fair Association will provide 1 Pork Chop approximately ½” thick. Contestants may bring their seasoning of choice from home. Parents will be allowed to start the fire and can help with turning the meat, but contestants should be able to do most of the cooking. No garnish or foil allowed in the turn in container!!
5. Check-in will take place Friday, August 28th from 3-5 PM at the Fayette County Fair Exhibit Hall. Contestants will pick up their pork chops at that time. Pork Chop turn in will be promptly at 4:15 PM on Saturday, August 29th. Award presentations will immediately follow judging (approximately 5:15-5:30 PM).
