These forms must be returned via email to FCFQUEENTX@GMAIL.COM no later than the deadline of **FRIDAY, JUNE 14, at 4:00 pm or before all 10 spots have been filled, whichever is sooner.**

THE FAYETTE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION WILL ACCEPT THE FIRST 10 CONTESTANTS THAT TURN IN THEIR **COMPLETED APPLICATION AND PHOTO** via email. Once the 10 spots for Queen have been filled, recruitment will be CLOSED.

We will then see you at the required contestant's meeting and ticket kickoff event on Monday, July 1, 6 pm to be held at Fayette County Fairground's Exhibit Hall!

2024 Fayette County Fair Queen Contestant Handbook

1. Contestant must have been at birth, born as a female; and be classified as a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior in a Fayette County School or be Home Schooled within Fayette County in the 2024/25 school year and/or reside in Fayette County full time. Contestant, if chosen Queen or a part of the queen's court, must remain enrolled as a student unless graduating in the spring.
2. Contestant's male escort for the Queen's pageant event must have the same scholastic status and age qualifications, and must be, and must have been at birth, born a male.
3. Contestant must in good standing within the community and school to promote a positive image, be in good health and have moral character.
4. Contestant must be single, never married, not given birth to a child or currently expecting a child.
5. Contestant must not engage in activities that if disclosed in public would result in bringing the contestant or Fair Association ridicule or embarrassment, including but not limited to inappropriate behavior on social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Snapchat, TikTok etc), any use of illegal drugs, alcohol, any illegal behavior or activity, professional or amateur nude or seminude dancing or modeling in any sexually oriented business or club, any type of nude or seminude photographs or video tapes, any felony convictions, deferred adjudication or probation, any conviction for a misdemeanor crime involving moral turpitude.
6. Contestants, parents, families, sponsors will be upheld to a NO BULLYING policy. Bullying is defined as intentional aggressive behavior that can take many forms (verbal, physical, direct, indirect and cyber bullying). Bullying can be one individual bullying another, a group ganging up against an individual, or targeting a group. No bullying will be tolerated towards other contestants, families, fair volunteers, business owners, fair patrons, etc. Acts of bullying can result in a warning and/or disqualification depending on the severity of aggression displayed.
7. Contestant understands that she nor family/members will disclose to anyone via verbal, text, social media, print including posters, brochures or business cards, etc. her intent of running for 2024 Fayette County Fair Queen until the formal announcement is made via newspaper, radio and official fair website

and Facebook page (approximately June 20, 2024). Under penalty of \$500.00 total sales deduction for violation.

8. Contestants will be sponsored by a Fayette County Non-Profit Organization. The Non-Profit Organization will provide their EIN number for our records as the organization receives 10% of the contestant's total season pass sales as a donation. The sponsor will support the contestant in her sale of tickets, this can include but not limited to: covering the cost of signage and banners, assisting in sale of tickets, listed as a contact persons on materials to buy tickets, organize/host special ticket sale events within the community, etc. There is not an entry fee to participate in the queen's contest.
9. The first 10 contestants completing their form, photo and consent will be accepted for the Queen's pageant. All forms and photo must be scanned and submitted electronically to email: fcfqueentx@gmail.com
10. Contestant must return **Completed Contestant Form and Photo** to be submitted to the newspapers and Notice of Contestant Intent Handbook Receipt and Rule Acknowledgement Form no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, June 14 or prior to the first 10 spots being filled to be considered as a Queen's Contestant. If you are contestant number 11, you will be placed as an alternate if any situation should arise for the first 10 contestants prior to the June 20th announcement.
11. All tickets will be issued at the July 1, 2024 Contestant's meeting.
 - Season passes to be sold at a price of \$35 each.
12. Season pass totals will be tallied by number of tickets sold.
13. Season passes will be sold online via FayetteCountyFair.org and can be purchased through the contestants NAME. A URL will be provided to you for a direct link.
14. If you wish to "partner" with a Jr Miss contestant, this is encouraged but not required as they will be selling Carnival Passes while you are selling Season Passes.
15. Photos to be judged in the "Miss Photogenic" contest must be submitted by 5:00 pm on July 15, 2024. This photo must be a **submitted to** [**fcfqueentx@gmail.com**](mailto:fcfqueentx@gmail.com)
16. **Awards:**
 - Queen-\$2800 (minimum) scholarship, crown, sash, floral bouquet, trophy, gift basket

1st Runner Up-\$2300 (minimum) scholarship, crown, sash, floral bouquet, trophy

2nd Runner Up-\$1800 scholarship (minimum), crown, sash, floral bouquet, trophy

Miss Photogenic- trophy, floral bouquet

Miss Congeniality- trophy, floral bouquet

Miss Poise and Beauty- trophy, floral bouquet

All contestants must sell at least 50 season passes to receive the \$300 scholarship, the participant prize bag filled with gift cards and gifts from area businesses in addition to participating in the Pageant. Volunteers work endless hours preparing for a night that everyone will remember, we want you to give 100% as well!

17. Incentive scholarship monies for placing queens are available as chart explains here with sales over 500 season passes:

**Any sales over 1000, will continue to increase by 100 with the added scholarship award increased by \$100.				

18. Contestants must attend the mandatory Fair Appreciation Dinner at the Fairgrounds on Sunday, August 25 (date to be confirmed) at 6:00 pm wearing the 2024 Fayette County Fair T-shirt along with jeans. You will receive this T-shirt at the bank when you turn in your ticket sales. If the contestant does not attend, a fine may be enforced and decided upon by the pageant committee. The contestant's sponsors and parents are also invited and encouraged to attend.
19. Ticket monies are turned in every Monday to the queen's account (NBT Bank, La Grange) you will be provided with deposit slips for each week at the ticket meeting. We understand that a deposit may not be available and if this

occurs, please contact a committee person (listed on page 1) and let them know.

20. Contestant or anyone representing the contestant may not contact the management of any of the musicians playing at the fair to link their ticket sales to them directly. This can deem the contact between the FCF and the artist, null and void and are grounds for immediate termination from the Scholarship Pageant.
21. Contestant must turn in all ticket sale proceeds on Wednesday, August 28 at 5:30 pm. Sale proceeds not turned in by 6:00 pm will be subject to a penalty of \$500.00 at 6:01 pm with the same penalty applied for each 15 minutes of tardiness thereafter. The Queen Pageant rehearsal will follow.
22. The Fair Queen Pageant will be held the evening of Thursday, August 29. Contestant must be present and ready for presentation with escort at 6:30 pm (subject to change). All gowns must be in good taste and not too revealing. Contestants will wait for the pageant to begin in an air-conditioned facility. After contestant's arrival, only touch-ups to hair and make-up will be permitted. Only the contestant will be allowed in the make ready area due to limited space.
23. We understand that the Queen and Queen's Court are expected to participate to the fullest extent possible in the parades and public events scheduled for the Fall/Winter and Spring/Summer, and in no less the 80% of the events scheduled. Tentative schedule is 20 parades for the year and 2 community service activities. Fayette County parades are required participation by the court. In each event, the participant must dress appropriately and wear the proper attire. A schedule with matching colored attire is provided and participant will follow guidelines. Should the expected participation be difficult or impossible due to intervening factors, the Chairperson shall be contacted at the earliest opportunity. The Queen, 1st Runner Up and 2nd Runner Up will be riding the float. The court is asked to download the GROUPME app for group text information and updates.
24. If for any reason should the Fair Queen not be able to fulfill her duties in accordance to these rules and regulations, the 1st Runner Up shall be named Fair Queen and duly authorized to perform in this capacity.
25. The sole authority and judgement as to the sufficient performance or deficiency in performance of a contestant is stipulated to be within the sole discretion of the Board of Directors of the Fayette County Fair Association

upon report and recommendation of the Queen Contest Committee Chairperson.

A contestant may be disqualified, and a reigning Queen or member of the Queen's Court may be removed and her scholarship forfeited at any time within the sole and absolute discretion of the Board of Directors of the Fayette County Fair Association.

We understand that we should make inquiry and receive approval from the Chairperson when we have questions. We and the Chairperson will always strive to be civil and cooperative in resolving problems and issues.

26. Contestants will request a second phone number via google (we will walk through this at the ticket meeting if assistance is needed) to assist in marketing and sales. This number is free of charge to create and will protect the contestant from outside intrusion. Contestants are advised not to use personal phone numbers for marketing and sales activity. However, this is optional and know it is a family affair.
27. We understand that the Fayette County Fair Association has no insurance coverage for health care or accidental injury to contestants, volunteers, or family; nor liability coverage for any acts of contestants, queen, queen's court, volunteers, and family.
28. To the extent provided by law, contestant, queen, queen's court, parent(s), and guardian(s) release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Fayette County Fair Association from any damage or injury to contestant, queen, queen's court, parent(s), and guardian(s), and volunteers while participating in furtherance of the contestant, queen, or queen's court activities, and any damage or injury to others by such activities,
29. We consent to the use of the contest, queen, queen's court likeness, photo, video, voice and biographic information for ticket sale and other Fair publicity, and the retention as an archive of Fayette County Fair Queen Contest history.

We and each one of us agree that the terms and requirements stated are fair and reasonable and each of us agree to abide by them.

 - Tickets go on sale July 1 to patrons.
 - You can begin hanging posters, posting on social media, passing out cards, calling customers, etc on July 1, 2024 after the fair ticket meeting! Don't jump the gun, PLEASE!!

- Fair tickets will be distributed at the REQUIRED ticket meeting on Monday, July 1 at 6:00 pm at the Fayette County Fair Grounds Exhibit Hall (400 W Fairgrounds Rd, La Grange, Texas 78945).
- Season Passes are required to be sold at \$35 each. In case someone asks, the daily admission to the fair is as follows:
 - Thursday - Free to all*
 - Friday - \$10.00*
 - Saturday - \$30.00*
 - Sunday - \$20.00*
 - Children 5 and under - free every day*
 - Children 6-15 years: free before 6 PM each day, after 6 PM the daily price*
- Online season ticket sales will be offered for the contestants, you will receive a URL for your online sales the week of June 18th after the contestants are released.
- Contestants must turn in all ticket sale proceeds on Wednesday, August 28, 2024 at 5:30 pm. Sales not turned in by 6:00 pm will be subject to a penalty of \$500.00 at 6:01 pm with the same penalty applied for each 15 minutes of tardiness thereafter.
- The Queen Pageant rehearsal will follow at 6:30 pm on August 28, bring your shoes and your escort.
- The Fair Queen Pageant will be on Thursday, August 29. Contestant must be present and ready for presentation with escort at TIME TBD. All gowns must be in good taste and not too revealing. Contestants will wait for the pageant to begin in an air-conditioned facility. After contestant's arrival, only touch-ups to hair and make-up will be permitted.
- The Queen's court will receive a schedule of activities to attend for the weekend of the fair, the court is the face of the fair and is expected to be on the grounds to appear at events with their crown and sash.
