

Czhilispiel 49 Scholarship Pageant Rules

Little Mister Czhilispiel

Parade Requirement: Each member of the court must ride in at least 9 parades and do 2 service projects as a court.

1. The Czhilispiel Scholarship Pageant will take place at the Flatonia ISD Cafetorium on **Saturday, October 9th, 2021, and will begin at 5:00 p.m.**
2. The contestant must live in or attend the Flatonia Independent School District FULL TIME. A contestant that lives with a parent or guardian within the Fisd only part-time IS NOT eligible to run for the Czhilispiel Court.
3. The Little Mister contestants must be **MALE** and at least five years old but no older than seven years of age on September 1, 2021. Any student who is four years of age or younger or eight years of age or older on September 1, 2021, will not be eligible for this category.
4. Contestants must not have unnatural colored hair such as bright red, blue, green, orange, yellow, purple, pink, etc. Piercings are limited to the ears and cannot be gauges. No visible tattoos; temporary or permanent.
5. **Deadline for entering the scholarship pageant is Tuesday, September 7th, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.** All applications must be submitted to the Flatonia Chamber of Commerce office. No applications will be accepted by fax, e-mail, or regular mail.
6. A **4 x 6 color photo** turned in with application is required for consideration in the “Most Photogenic” category. No other size photo will be judged. The color photo may be a regular snapshot or professional photo. The color photo must accompany the application and are both due to the Flatonia Chamber of Commerce office by Tuesday, September 7th, 2021 at 6:00.
 - a. On the back of each picture, please write: 1) the contestant’s name, 2) age of contestant on pageant date, and 3) the age group of competitors (Little Mister).
 - b. If a 4 x 6 color photo does not accompany the application, the contestant will not be judged for “Most Photogenic” or have their picture submitted to the local newspaper.
7. A \$30.00 non-refundable entry fee will be required of each contestant, paid by the parent or guardian of each contestant, and is due at the time of application submission.
8. The judging of the contestants will be based on the following:
 - a. Private Interview – Contestants will meet and talk with judges individually. Scores will be based on poise, personality, and appearance.
 - b. Evening Attire during the Pageant – Little Mister Contestants may wear a long sleeve dress shirt and dress slacks, or nice blue jeans with boots or dress shoes, and a cowboy hat is optional. No visible tattoos; temporary or permanent, and no ear piercings.
9. A panel of out-of-town judges will do all judging and tabulation of scores. Judges decisions are final. All score sheets are confidential, will not be discussed or reviewed after the Pageant, and are destroyed by the judges the night of the pageant.

10. **Private interviews with the pageant judges will take place at the Civic Center, with the first interview starting at approximately 1:00 p.m. the day of the pageant.** Please arrive 10 minutes before your interview. Dress should be casual but appropriate for an interview setting.
11. Parents and legal guardians may **NOT** stay with their children backstage during rehearsal times or during the pageant. Someone will be there to assist your child during rehearsal and pageant.
12. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - a. Little Mister Czihilispiel will receive a \$75.00 cashier's check, belt buckle, trophy, and sash.
 - b. Little Mister Czihilispiel 1st Runner-Up will receive a \$25.00 cashier's check and a sash.
 - c. Little Mister Czihilispiel 2nd Runner-Up will receive a sash.
 - d. Winners are required to ride on the float in the Czihilispiel parade on Sunday, October 24th, 2021. The parade will begin at 12:00 p.m. (noon) therefore the winners should be at the float location no later than 11:00 a.m.
 - e. The pageant judges will choose "Most Photogenic" winners. There is an award of a sash for this category. Photogenic winners do not ride the float.
13. Once a contestant is crowned Little Mister Czihilispiel he may no longer run for the title of Little Mister again, regardless of age eligibility.
14. Each winner must always represent Flatonia in a manner that reflects well on the Chamber and the City of Flatonia.
15. The winner must participate in any events throughout the year that are arranged by the Chamber, such as but not limited to "Christmas in Flatonia", and the Chamber's Annual Mixer in January.
16. Czihilispiel weekend - The Court will be given a List of Events with approximate times prior to Czihilispiel weekend that each member of the Court needs to be at for photos and to represent Czihilispiel during the weekend event. Czihilispiel is a 3 day event and by signing the rules to run in any age group the contestant (with accompanying parent and/or guardian) are agreeing to be at the entire Czihilispiel Festival as requested by the Chamber.
17. The Flatonia Chamber of Commerce will pay for two car magnets for each of the 1st Place age group winners. The cost of the optional yard signs will be the responsibility of the winners, if they choose to order them.
18. If for any reason during the year a winner is unable to serve his duties, the 1st Runner-Up will serve the remainder of the year if he has followed the guidelines set forth in this Set of Rules. The Chamber Board of Directors will determine if the Runner-Up meets the criteria.
19. The Flatonia Chamber of Commerce will **NOT** pay to replace or repair any awards. If an award must be replaced or repaired, it will be the responsibility of the winner to pay for the repair or replacement.
20. Each member of the current outgoing reigning court is required to help decorate for the following year's pageant. The decorating will be each evening, beginning at 6pm on the Monday night before the Pageant. On Friday, October 8th, which is the day before the Pageant, beginning as early as 3:30pm, or when school is released, **the entire court AND a parent** are required to meet at the cafetorium to finish up the stage decorating. (We understand that this is football season, but the decorating cannot be finished until this day.) This also includes the foyer of the cafetorium which is the sole responsibility of the outgoing court to decorate with their plaques,

trophies & ribbons, and pictures from the past year's parades and events. **No decorating allowance is provided for decorating the foyer.**

21. All Runner-ups, Photogenic, and Congeniality winners are encouraged to also ride in the parade but as a separate group. This parade entry needs to be organized by a parent from this group of winners. A list of all winners can be obtained by contacting the Pageant Director.

The following is a List of Parades that the Chamber would like you to ride in. These specific parades were chosen so that Flatonia will be represented, to promote & advertise the Czhlispiel Event, and to encourage other towns to attend and participate in our Hometown Czhlispiel Parade. The remainder of the 9 parades required may be selected by the court. **The Czhlispiel Parades do not count towards your parade requirement.**

- Smithville Jamboree Parade April 2022
- TomTom Festival, Yoakum. June 2022
- Luling Watermelon Thump Parade June 2022
- Muldoon 4th of July parade July 4th 2022
- Moulton Jamboree Parade July 2022
- Schulenburg Festival Parade Aug 2022
- Kolache Festival, Hallettsville Sept 2022
- Fayette County Fair Parade Sept 2022
- Come and Take It Parade, Gonzales Oct. 2022

For your outgoing parade at Czhlispiel you will need to find a vehicle to ride in as a group or on your own. This is not mandatory but does look nice when everyone is involved.

Christmas Parades: these will be extra parades you can do but are not mandatory you will need to decide as a group to go. There is **NO allowance** for decorating the float for Christmas parades.

In the event that you cannot be at a parade, it is your responsibility to call the runner-ups to see if they can fill in for you. You then need to let Miss Czhlispiel know the arrangements that have been made so that she can make sure the runner-ups know where to be, what to wear, and times. You will need to make plans to make up any missed parades as each member of the Court is required to attend a minimum of 9 parades. **If the court, as a group, chooses to ride in more than the 9 required parades, they must all agree and all participate.**

If any member of the court does not ride in at least the required 9 parades prior to the pageant the following year, they will **NOT** receive the Scholarship/Cashier's Check for that year. If you are making up a parade on your own, you will need to find a vehicle and ask Miss Czhlispiel for your magnets for the parade so that you can put them on your vehicle. It is Miss Czhlispiel's responsibility to keep a log

of who rides in which parades so you will need to notify her of any that you ride in so she can add them to your name on her log. If there are any questions about this, contact the Chamber or Pageant Director.

Dress code on the float for Little Mister during parades will be as follows:

The chosen Shirt color is the decision of Miss Czihilspiel, and will be decided on at the Sunday meeting after the pageant clean-up. Once the color of the shirt has been chosen, you will have until 12/1/2021 to purchase his parade outfit.

Little Mister may wear a shirt with a collar (no T-shirts) and dress slacks or nice blue jeans with boots or dress shoes, and a cowboy hat is optional. No ear piercings. No visible tattoos; temporary or permanent.

Also, the Court is required to provide a color photo of them as a group in a jpeg or pdf format to the Chamber before January 1, 2022. This photo **does not** have to be taken by a “professional photographer”. The Chamber will use this group picture on its website.

Parade Etiquette: Failure to follow these guidelines will be addressed by the Pageant Director and/or the Chamber if necessary.

- Hair should be fixed and kept clear of the face so that smiles will be seen.
- Boots or dress shoes only!
- Sunglasses should not be worn on the float during judging or while the float is moving. NO Exceptions!
- No Electronic Devices are allowed on the float during judging or while the float is moving.
- The only item the Court is allowed to have sitting on the floor of the float during judging, or while the float is moving, is a water bottle.
- While the Court is on the float; smiling, waving, and thanking people is appropriate. Remember you are being watched at all times and are a direct representation of Flatonia and the Chamber of Commerce. It is not appropriate to yell or make other comments at passersby for any reason.
- NO gum is allowed on the float during judging or while the float is moving.
- The Chamber requires each member of the Court to have a parent/guardian with them at each Parade and/or Event that they participate in. Due to liability reasons, NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule will be made.
- Additionally, ALL FLOAT PARTICIPANTS of a parade are required to help with the setting-up and tearing down of the float before and after a parade. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The 2021-22 newly Crowned 1st Place Winners, and at least 1 parent each, will be expected to help clean up from the pageant at 1:00pm on Sunday, October 10th, 2021.

Immediately following the clean-up there will also be a mandatory meeting held at the FISS Cafetorium. Each 1st Place winner of the Court, and at least 1 parent each, need to be at this meeting to take notes and prepare for upcoming events. Runner-Ups and Most Photogenic winners DO NOT attend this meeting.
