





The Honorable Wilton Simpson Commissioner Florida Department of Agriculture



A lifelong Florida farmer and entrepreneur, Commissioner Simpson has deep personal and professional roots grounded in agriculture, including a large-scale egglaying operation that supplies eggs for Florida's families through supermarkets across the state.

From 2012 to 2022, Commissioner Simpson served as a member of the Florida Senate and was elected Senate President for the 2020-2022 term. Serving as Senate President through a world-wide pandemic came with many unique challenges, but Commissioner Simpson fought to keep Florida open and free and to ensure that Florida was a beacon of hope, opportunity and freedom for generations to come.

The Commissioner of Agriculture oversees the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
