

## TEXAS TICKET PURCHASE BY CITY





# Wine & Food Week Hall of Fame Inductees Chris Shepherd & Lindsey Brown



Chris Shepherd, the visionary James Beard award-winning chef behind Underbelly Hospitality, has also redefined what it means to celebrate local cuisine. Chris' passion and creativity earned him a long list of accolades but also created a community where food tells a story, bridging cultures and generations.

Chris was named one of the 10 Best New Chefs in America by Food & Wine in 2013 and was then awarded the 2014 James Beard Award for Best Chef in the Southwest. He was a semifinalist for the James Beard Award for Outstanding Chef in 2019 and named Robb Report's Chef of the Year in the same year.

Together with his wife Lindsey the two co-founded Southern Smoke Foundation which to-date has distributed more than \$11.7 million directly to people in the food and beverage industry in need via the Emergency Relief Fund. The reach of which is far and wide. Wine & Food Week is inducting Chris Shepherd and his wife, Lindsey Brown in the Wine & Food Week Hall of Fame at the opening ceremonies and official toast of the Wine Rendezvous Grand Tasting & Chef Showcase.



Encebollado, a dish which originates from Ecuador's Valdiva culture known for their culinary lifestyle using seafood and local herbs. Salted fish, and cassava are cooked in water, red onion tanned in lemon and salt, a drizzle of olive oil, parsley and a broth made from tomatoes, onions, chili, coriander, and cumin to form a base for the soup, called sofrito.


