



ston Chronicle restaurant critic Alison Cook's list of the Top 100 restaurants in Houston

The list, announced Thursday night during the Chronicle's annual Culinary Stars event, is Houston's most eagerly awaited assessment of the Houston restaurant scene

Kata Robata chef, the much-admired Manabu Horiuchi, was traveling in Japan and was not present to hear his nar during the countdown to the list's best restaurant in Houston. Yun Cheng, owner of the Azuma Group that owns and operates Azuma, Soma, Kata Robata and Izakaya, accepted the award along with sous chef Takahisa Onishi

This award is on behalf of all the Kata team members who come to work every day with such passion and commitment: Cheng said. "We're just so happy to be a part of this dining culture in Houston.

About 700 guests attended Culinary Stars which featured wine and bites from more than 30 of the city's best restaurants The food included smoked brisket rigatorii from Killen's STQ; Akaushi smoked dry-age short rib with kimchi and Yukon gold mashed potatoes from Tris; butternut squash gnoechi with house-cured pancetta and sage butter from Weights + Measures: blackened quail with sweet potato and spiced pecans form Poitin; pan-seared Maine scallop with roasted butternut squash from Lucienne; ahi tuna and crab Napoleon from Tony's; and fresh cacao beans with shrimp and chori

was more: Roostar Vietnamese grill sent out spicy papaya salad with shrimp; Soto's Cantina prepared roasted guaji chile enchiladas stuffed with gueso fresco and topped with potato and chorizo hash; Veranda Progressive Indian Quising offered lemon pepper chicken with mango gastrique; 1751 Sea and Bar made ahi tuna sashimi on taro chips; Tejas Chocolate + Barbecue offered smoked beef shank empanadas; Blood Bros. BBQ fashioned turkey banh mi sandwich Himalaya Restaurant served achari chicken curry with masala rice.

There were 20 new additions to the 2019 Top 100 list. Cook made 371 restaurant visits during her year of evaluating restaurants.
