# **RULES:**

- 1. This show is subject to the Fort Bend County Fair Association General Rules and Regulations and the Livestock General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. There is no entry fee for the Scramble Heifer Show.

- 3. Scramble heifers are eligible to enter the FBCF Junior Heifer and Bull Show to be held September 21, 2024. It's the exhibitor's responsibility to complete all the necessary entry information along with the required entry fees.
- 4. The Scramble Heifer Show will be a "Blow and Go Show". No grooming materials of any kind will be allowed at showtime.
- 5. There will only be one Showmanship Class for all the Scramble Heifer exhibitors. Exhibitors called back for Showmanship must show their own project (animal) no substitute project (animal) allowed.
- 6. All Heifers must be secured with a neck rope.
- 7. Your Scramble Heifer is not eligible for the Jr. Market Livestock Auction or the Commercial Heifer Auction.

### 8. <u>Judge's decision is final.</u>

9. All exhibitors must supply pine shavings for their stall.

#### 10. Scramble Stalls

- All scramble heifers will be stalled in the designated Calf Scramble Area
- Heifer(s) are stalled by club/chapter
- Stall size: 4' wide by 8' tall
- Side panels, fans, and showboxes are allowed within your assigned area
- All decorating must be tasteful and non-offensive
- Fair Management has the right to remove any questionable decorations
- 11. Scramble Heifer exhibitors must prepare a monthly report on their projects. The report should include expenses and updates on your heifer's progress. Reports are due in the Fort Bend County Fair Association Office by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. You are also required to send a copy to your sponsor and Agricultural Science Teacher or County Extension Agent. Please remember without our sponsors this program won't be possible.
- 12. Each exhibitor is required to write an essay titled, "My Calf Scramble Project" with a minimum of 250 words. Your essay and notebook are due on or before September 29, 2024 to the Fort Bend County Fair Association Office to be eligible to show. You may also include a copy of your essay in your Notebook combined with your monthly reports, and photos.
- 13. Check-out time is Sunday, October 6, 2024, from 7:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. There will be no early check-out. Scramble Heifers entering in the FBCF Jr. Heifer Show **may not** check out early with FBCF Jr. Heifers on Saturday.
- 14. All decisions are subject to change by decision of the Fort Bend County Fair Board of Directors without prior notice.
