

# CREATIVE ARTS DEPARTMENT DIVISION RULES

### **DIVISION 1 – BAKED GOODS**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. All exhibits must be entered in or on disposable containers or will not be accepted.
- 2. Any item requiring refrigeration (i.e., cream cheese, whipped cream) will only be accepted on Thursday from 8 a.m. to noon.
- 3. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

### **DIVISION 2– CANNED GOODS**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Canned Foods must be a regulation canning jar. Jars and lids must be clean and rust free.
- 2. Unsealed jars will be disqualified.
- 3. No lid skirts, labels or decorations of any kind on jars or they will be eliminated.
- 4. All exhibits are judged on appearance.
- 5. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

### <u>DIVISION 3 – NEEDLEWORK</u>

### Section Rules:

- 1. Needlework is entered by technique.
- 2. Limit of five (5) items per Exhibitor: Three (3) per class.
- 3. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

Class 2 – Needlepoint Class 5 – Smocking Class 8 – Miscellaneous Handwork

Class 3 – Counted Cross Stitch Class 6 – Knitting Class 9 - Professional

### **DIVISION 4 – QUILTS**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Items must be pieced and/or quilted by entrant.
- 2. Limit of Five (5) entries per exhibitor. Three (3) per class.
- 3. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

# **DIVISION 5 – SEWING MACHINE ARTICLES**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Limit of three (3) exhibits per class.
- 2. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

Class 2 – Monogram / Embroidery Work Class 5 – Miscellaneous Class 3 – Pillows Class 6 – Professional

### **DIVISION 6 – ANTIQUES**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Limit of ten (10) items per exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibit must be near original condition and fifty (50) years or older.
- 3. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

Class 1 – Glass/Crystal/China Class 6 – Children's Toys Class 11 – Wooden items Class 2 - Ironstone, Pottery, Crockery Class 7 – Tools Class 12 – Miscellaneous Class 3 – Photographs, Drawings, Paintings Class 8 – Books/Paper Items Class 13 – Professional

Class 4 – Jewelry Class 9 – Furniture & Furnishings

Class 5 – Silver, Pewter, Misc. Metals Class 10 – Textiles

### **DIVISION 7 – ARTS & CRAFTS**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Limit of five (5) items per exhibitor.
- 2. Metal Work or Leaded Glass must be free standing or ready to hang.
- 3. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

Class 1 – Ceramics Class 6 – Weaving Class 11 - Refurbished/Recycled Class 2 – Leather Work Class 7 – Metal Work Class 12 - Scroll Saw Wood Work Class 3 – Decorated / Painted Clothing Class 8 – Leaded Glass Class 13 - Jewelry Class 4 – Decorated / Painted Articles Class 9 – Wood Work Class 14 – Painted Wood Class 5 – Decoupage Articles Class 10 – Dolls Class 15 - Miscellaneous Class 16 - Professional

### **DIVISION 8 – COLLECTIONS**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Collections must be properly mounted or displayed.
- 2. Limit of three (3) different types of collections per exhibitor.

Class 1 – Collection of two (2) to six (6) items Class 2 – Collection of seven (7) to ten (10) items

Class 3 – Professional (no rosette)

# **DIVISION 9 – VISUAL ARTS**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Limit of ten (10) items per exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibits must be framed and ready to hang with wire strung from side to side at least two (2) inches from the top of the frame.
- 3. Large or heavy paintings are accepted at the option of the Advisory Council.
- 4. No frame required for "gallery wrap" but must be wired.
- 5. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

Class 1 – Oils Class 4 – Pencil, Crayon, Pen, Ink Class 7 – Professional

Class 2 – Acrylic Class 5 – Water Color, Casein, Tempera

Class 3 - Pastels, Charcoal Class 6 – Miscellaneous

# **DIVISION 10 – PHOTOGRAPHY**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Exhibit must be mounted on foam board. No mats excepted.
- 2. Photographs must be 8" x 10" only and no larger will be accepted
- 3. Exhibit must be original photograph by exhibitor only.
- 4. Limit of six (6) photographs per exhibitor.
- 5. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.
- Class 1 Black & White
- Class 2 -Color
- Class 3 Professional

# **DIVISION 11 – FLORAL**

#### Section Rules:

- 1. Exhibitor must furnish name of his/her exhibit in horticulture.
- 2. Categories in horticulture must have been grown in presented container by exhibitor or be for at least six (6) weeks prior to the Fair.
- 3. Dish Gardens and Terrariums in Class 1, 2, 3, and 4 must be the work of the exhibitor. No time limit is imposed on the Dish Gardens and Terrariums.
- 4. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.

### Please provide drainage trays for pots when needed.

Class 2 - A - Herbs B - Vegetables

(Loose vegetables must be in a basket or container)

Class 3 – Fresh Flower Arrangements

- 1. Flowers need not be grown by exhibitor and may be replaced as needed during Fair.
- 2. This class may include one (1) accessory.
- 3. No artificial foliage or flower material may be used.

Class 4 – Miscellaneous

# **DIVISION 12 – HOLIDAY**

### Section Rules:

- 1. Exhibit themes related to any Holiday. Examples: Christmas, Thanksgiving, Easter, 4th of July, etc....
- 2. A limit of ten (10) items per exhibitor
- 3. Professional entrants will not receive rosettes.
