



CREATIVE ARTS DEPARTMENT DIVISION RULES

DIVISION 1 – BAKED GOODS

Section Rules:

1. All exhibits must be entered in or on disposable containers.
2. Any item requiring refrigeration (i.e., cream cheese, whipped cream) will only be accepted on Thursday from 8 a.m. to noon.

Class 1 – Breads
Class 2 – Cakes
Class 3 – Cookies

Class 4 – Cheesecakes
Class 5 – Pies
Class 6 – Candies

Class 7 – Cupcakes/Muffins
Class 8 – Miscellaneous

DIVISION 2– CANNED GOODS

Section Rules:

1. Canned Foods must be a regulation canning jar. Jars and lids must be clean and rust free.
2. Unsealed jars will be disqualified.
3. No lid skirts on jars.
4. All exhibits are judged on appearance.

DIVISION 3 – NEEDLEWORK

Section Rules:

1. Fancy Work I is entered by technique.
2. Limit of ten (10) items per Exhibitor: Five (5) per class.

Class 1 – Embroidery
Class 2 – Needlepoint
Class 3 – Counted Cross Stitch

Class 4 – Lace
Class 5 – Smocking
Class 6 – Knitting

Class 7 – Crochet
Class 8 – Miscellaneous Handwork

DIVISION 4 – QUILTS

Section Rules:

1. Items must be pieced and/or quilted by entrant.

Class 1 – Pieced, Hand Quilted
Class 2 – Pieced, Machine Quilted
Class 3 – Pieced, 2 Persons
Class 4 – Appliqué, Hand Quilted

Class 5 – Appliqué, Machine Quilted
Class 6 – Appliqué, 2 Persons
Class 7 – Wall Quilts, 45 inches or less
Class 8 – Group Quilts, 3 or more

Class 9 – Art & Mixed Media
Class 10 – Quilted Clothing
Class 11 – Professional
Class 12 – Miscellaneous

DIVISION 5 – SEWING MACHINE ARTICLES

Section Rules:

1. Limit of three (3) exhibits per class.

Class 1 – Clothing
Class 2 – Monogram / Embroidery Work
Class 3 – Pillows

Class 4 – Toys
Class 5 – Miscellaneous
Class 6 – Professional (Not eligible for a Rosette)

DIVISION 6 – ANTIQUES

Section Rules:

1. Limit of fifteen (15) items per exhibitor.
2. Exhibit must be near original condition and fifty (50) years or older.

Class 1 – Glass/Crystal

Class 2 – China

Class 3 – Ironstone, Pottery, Crockery

Class 4 – Photographs, Drawings, Paintings

Class 5 – Jewelry

Class 6 – Silver, Pewter, Misc. Metals

Class 7 – Children’s Toys

Class 8 – Tools

Class 9 – Books/Paper Items

Class 10 – Furniture & Furnishings

Class 11 – Antique Collections (4 or more)

Class 12 – Textiles

Class 13 – Wooden items

Class 14 – Miscellaneous

DIVISION 7 – ARTS & CRAFTS

Section Rules:

1. Limit of ten (10) items per exhibitor.
2. Metal Work or Leaded Glass must be free standing or ready to hang.

Class 1 – Ceramics

Class 2 – Leather Work

Class 3 – Decorated / Painted Clothing

Class 4 – Decorated / Painted Articles

Class 5 – Decoupage Articles

Class 6 – Weaving

Class 7 – Metal Work

Class 8 – Leaded Glass

Class 9 – Wood Work

Class 10 – Dolls

Class 11 – Refurbished/Recycled

Class 12 – Scroll Saw Wood Work

Class 13 – Miscellaneous

DIVISION 8 – COLLECTIONS

Section Rules:

1. Collections must be properly mounted or displayed.
2. Limit of three (3) different types of collections per exhibitor.

Class 1 – Collection of four (4) to ten (10) items

Class 2 – Collection of more than ten (10) items

DIVISION 9 – VISUAL ARTS

Section Rules:

1. Limit of ten (10) items per exhibitor.
2. Exhibits must be framed and ready to hang with wire strung from side to side at least two (2) inches from the top of the frame.
3. Large or heavy paintings are accepted at the option of the Advisory Council.
4. No framing for “gallery wrap” but must be wired.
5. Beginners will be judged for 1 Rosette overall.

Divisions: I – Beginner (original work)
II – Advanced (original work)
III – Professional (Not eligible for Rosettes)

Class 1 – Oils

Class 2 – Water Color, Casein, Tempera

Class 3 – Pastels, Charcoal

Class 4 – Pencil, Crayon, Pen, Ink

Class 5 – China Painting

Class 6 – Sculpture (no woodcarving)

Class 7 – Acrylic

Class 8 – Miscellaneous

DIVISION 10 – PHOTOGRAPHY

Section Rules:

1. Exhibit must be framed and ready to hang with screw eyes and wire.
Metal frames must be wired also. No plastic frames accepted.
2. Photographs must be at least 8” x 10” and no larger than 20” x 20” or panorama no longer than 24’.
3. Exhibit must be original photograph by exhibitor only.
4. Limit of six (6) photographs per exhibitor.

Class 1 – Black & White
Class 2 – Black & White Computer Enhanced
Class 3 – Color

Class 4 – Color Computer Enhanced
Class 5 – Professional

DIVISION 11 – FLORAL

Section Rules:

1. Exhibitor must furnish name of his/her exhibit in horticulture.
2. Categories in horticulture must have been grown by exhibitor or be in his/her possession at least six (6) weeks prior to the Fair.
3. Dish Gardens and Terrariums in Class 1, 2, 3, and 4 must be the work of the exhibitor. No time limit is imposed on the Dish Gardens and Terrariums. **Please provide drainage trays for pots when needed.**

Class 1 – Horticulture by Categories:

A – Ferns	D – Succulents	G – Terrariums
B – Flowering Plants	E – Cut Specimens	
C – Foliage Plants	F – Dish Gardens	

Class 2 – A – Herbs B – Vegetables
(Loose vegetables must be in a basket or container)

Class 3 – Artificial and/or Dried Material Arrangements

Class 4 – Fresh Flower Arrangements

1. Flowers need not be grown by exhibitor and may be replaced as needed during Fair.
2. This class may include one (1) accessory.
3. No artificial foliage or flower material may be used.

Class 5 – Professional

Class 6 – Miscellaneous

DIVISION 12 – HOLIDAY

Section Rules:

1. Exhibit themes related to any Holiday. Examples: Christmas, Thanksgiving, Easter, 4th of July, etc....

Class 1 – Valentine’s Day

Class 2 – Easter

Class 3 – 4th of July

Class 4 – Halloween

Class 5 – Thanksgiving

Class 6 – Christmas

Class 7 – Miscellaneous
