



# ***BOOTS & BUCKLES on The Bay***

## **Jr. Angler Fishing Tournament**

**May 18, 2024**

**Matagorda Tournament Pavilion**

**(Next to Harbor Bait & Tackle)**

**Matagorda, Texas**

### **Tournament Rules & Regulations**

1. Entry fee is \$50 per child age 15 and under and is limited to the first 50 paid entries. All entry fees must be paid by 8:30 pm May 17, 2023 (the day before the tournament). A release of liability must be signed by parent / legal guardian prior to start of tournament.
2. Jr. Angler must declare whether fishing as an individual in the Jr. Angler Tournament or as part of the 4-man team. Jr. Angler may not participate in both. Declaration must be made at the time of registration.
3. Captain's Party will be held at 7:00 pm at the Matagorda Bait & Tackle Shop in Matagorda on May 17, 2023 (location subject to change). The rules will be presented, and any questions will be answered.
4. The tournament officially begins at 6:00 am on Saturday, May 18, 2024, unless threatening weather is present (see Safety & Weather).
5. Fishing guides are not allowed to enter the tournament. Jr. Anglers may use a guide (at their expense). The guide is allowed to bait hooks, net fish, get out backlashes but is NOT allowed to cast or retrieve.
6. There are no boundaries. All waters fished during the tournament shall be legally accessible to the public.
7. All Jr. Anglers must leave and fish from one exclusive designated vessel (boat or truck). Jr. Anglers do not need boat access to enter the tournament.
8. All Jr. Anglers must always fish within plain eyesight of their exclusive vessel.
9. All fish must be caught by rod and reel in strict adherence to State Laws.
10. Live or artificial bait is acceptable. No bait acquired by illegal means, no pre-baiting fishing spots and no culling of dead fish.
11. All fish to be weighed in must be legal size (no oversized "tagged" redfish).

12. All fish to be weighed in must be caught after 6:00 am on May 18, 2024, when the tournament officially begins.

### **PAYOUT**

13. **GRAND CHAMPION REDFISH** - 20 – 28-inch slot on red fish (NO OVERSIZED REDS ARE ELIGIBLE). Grand Champion Buckle. **Additional prizes and places may be awarded based on the number of Jr. Angler entries. Places and awards to be paid will be announced at the Captain's Party.**
14. **GRAND CHAMPION FLOUNDER** - Grand Champion Buckle. **Additional prizes and places may be awarded based on the number of Jr. Angler entries. Places and awards to be paid will be announced at the Captain's Party.**
15. All entrants are subject to random polygraph testing. You must be present within 15 minutes if called for a test or you will be disqualified. Alcohol can affect the polygraph test results. Any entrant that is unable to complete or take the test will be disqualified.
16. The winner is determined by the heaviest weight. In the event of a tie, the fish weighed in first, WINS.
17. Violation of any rule or un-sportsman like behavior will disqualify the entrant.
18. A written protest can be made, accompanied by a \$300.00 cash fee no later than 4pm on the day of the tournament. The fee will be refunded if the protest is judged valid. The decision of the tournament director and their appointed committee (4 people min) concerning any tournament matters is final.

### **WEIGH-IN**

19. The weigh station will be located at Matagorda Harbor Pavilion, Matagorda, TX.
20. The weigh-in station will open at 1pm and close at 3pm the day of the tournament. To weigh in your fish, you must be recognized in line by a committee member before 3pm.
21. All fish will be weighed on the same scale.
22. Fish will be weighed in the following categories.
- a. Individual Heaviest Redfish
  - b. Individual Flounder

23. The largest fish in each category will be chosen by the contestant, weighed in one time and marked by the weigh master.
24. Any entrant who attempts to enter a fish that is not of legal size will be disqualified. No redfish over 28 inches will be accepted. **All fish must be caught by registered tournament entrants, during tournament hours, on the day of the tournament.** **ALL ANGLERS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE FISHING AND BOATING REGULATIONS AND ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL LICENSES/PERMITS REQUIRED BY LAW.**
25. Official records maintained by the weigh master and not the status board will determine the winner.
26. All fish submitted for weigh-in must be in a fresh, edible condition. Frozen, thawed, spoiled or mutilated fish, or fish altered from its natural state will be disqualified. Weigh master and tournament directors have final decision on validity of fish.

## **SAFETY & WEATHER**

27. Boat operators should check their safety equipment prior to the tournament, and it is recommended that while wade fishing, you wear a PFD.
28. If threatening weather is present, the tournament start may be delayed. The decision to delay the start time will be made at 6:00 am and not before. It is the responsibility of the contestants to verify the status of tournament by contacting Harbor Bait & Tackle at 979-863-7620.
29. If severe or threatening weather compels the tournament committee to cancel the tournament, the tournament will be rescheduled.
