If approved, your group will receive one (1) wristband for each fully executed Individual Participant Release Form received by the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show. All Parade participants must wear and display the wristband provided by the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show to enter the Parade route and as may be requested by a parade official.

<u>Health papers are required and will be checked by a Parade Marshal</u> on all horses and other equine entering the parade staging area and Parade. Please pay particular attention to the health requirements for horses and other equine as stated in the Health Requirements for Horses and Other Equine and the General Information and Special Parade Rules.

<u>All participants must be pre-registered</u>. <u>Faxed entries will not be accepted</u>. If you have any questions, contact Carol Clifton at 817-877-2436.

SOUTHWESTERN EXPOSITION AND LIVESTOCK SHOW 2023 ALL-WESTERN PARADE

GENERAL INFORMATION & SPECIAL PARADE RULES

- Date and Time: Saturday, January 14, 2023, 11:00 a.m.
- **Theme:** Western Heritage costumes and decorations encouraged.
- **Health Papers**: <u>All horses and other equine</u> are required to have proper health papers to participate in the parade or enter staging area. The health papers are to be on the rider at all times. See "Official Health Requirements" on the following page for mandatory health requirements on horses and other equine.
- ALL Parade participants must review and sign an Individual Participant Release Form.
- Parking/Unloading: There are two parking areas: Red Lot and Blue Lot. NOTE: Access to the parking area is restricted and you are required to follow the route stated below for Livestock Health Papers Checkln.

To enter the <u>Red Lot</u> (former LaGrave Field) - From Northside Drive turn south on N. Commerce St. to NE 10th St. Turn left on NE 10th St., then right on N. Calhoun St to Livestock Health Papers Check-In.

To enter the <u>Blue Lot</u> (former Tandy Lot) - From Interstate 30, go north on Forest Park Blvd. to Purcey St. Turn left on Purcey St. to Livestock Health Papers Check-In (<u>see attached Parking Lot Location Maps</u>).

• **Directions to Parade Route:** From the <u>Red Lot</u>, proceed south on N. Main St. across the Trinity River to Bluff St. behind the courthouse. Parade begins at the courthouse and travels south.

From the <u>Blue Lot</u>, proceed east on W. Belknap to Houston Street, turn left onto Bluff Street behind the courthouse. Parade begins at the courthouse and travels south.

- **Parade Route**: South from the courthouse on Main St. to 9th St., turn west, proceed to Houston St., travel north on Houston St. then returning to your appropriate parking lot. (*Grade on N. Main Street requires brakes for horse-drawn vehicles.*)
- Line-Up Numbers and Wristbands will be mailed in advance to the address provided on the parade entry form. Be sure your <u>LINE-UP NUMBER</u> is displayed on the <u>LEFT</u> side of the lead person or horse and is visible to Judges.
- **Judging**: Stock Show Parade Judges will be at the Main Street Reviewing Stand located between W. 2nd and W. 3rd Streets in the Sundance Plaza.
- Awards: First, second and third place for each category. Overall honors for Most Colorful Entry, Greatest
 Distance Traveled, Western Heritage Award and Chairman's Award. (Awards may be picked up at the Stock
 Show office or will be mailed to address on application.)

SOUTHWESTERN EXPOSITION AND LIVESTOCK SHOW 2023 ALL-WESTERN PARADE

OFFICIAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

The Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show is an interstate (accepting entries of livestock from within Texas and from other states) show with an All-Western Parade. Entries with livestock originating outside the state of Texas are encouraged to contact their state animal health officials to confirm specific requirements (if any) their state may impose on animals returning from a Texas show.

THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF THE SOUTHWESTERN EXPOSITION AND LIVESTOCK SHOW ANIMAL HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR ANIMALS ENTERING THE SHOW OR ALL-WESTERN PARADE. IN SOME INSTANCES, THESE REGULATIONS EXCEED CURRENT TEXAS ANIMAL HEALTH COMMISSION REGULATIONS THAT GOVERN MOVEMENT OF LIVESTOCK INTO SHOWS, FAIRS AND EXHIBITIONS. THESE REGULATIONS ARE CURRENT AT THE TIME OF PUBLISHING OF THIS YEAR'S SHOW AND PARADE. ANY NEW REGULATIONS WILL SUPERSEDE THIS SUMMARY IF THERE IS A DISPUTE BETWEEN THE TWO. HORSES (And Other Equine)

These regulations apply to all equine entering the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show All Western Parade and staging area.

TEXAS ORIGIN

A) Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test, also known as a "Coggins" Test, within the past twelve (12) months.

OUT OF STATE ORIGIN

- A) Original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within thirty (30) days.
- B) Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test, also known as a "Coggins" Test, within the past twelve (12) months. Test date, accession number and name of laboratory must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Exemption:

Equine may enter the All-Western Parade and staging area without a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection when accompanied by a valid equine interstate passport or equine identification card and a completed VS Form 10-11 showing negative results to an official EIA test within the previous six (6) months.

Humane Treatment. Humane treatment of animals (including helping horses) must be exercised at all times by all exhibitors and their employees. Animals that have been given any form of intoxicating beverages, tranquilizers or other drugs enhancing the performance, or affecting the mood or attitude of the animal prior to judging will be disqualified. Any inhumane treatment will be reported to the appropriate governing association.

Diseased Animals Barred. Efforts will be taken to ensure no animal(s) having a disease of any character will be admitted into the All-Western Parade or its staging areas at any time, and the Parade Chairman, Parade Veterinarian, or Stock Show President are authorized to refuse unloading privileges or remove any animal on the parade premises having a disease or undesirable ailment as determined by the official Stock Show Veterinarian or the Texas Animal Health Commission.

• Special Parade Rules:

- Musical instruments and individuals walking are not permitted with a Riding Club and Sheriff's Posses entry. Only horses and other equine are permitted.
- > Spectator and participant safety are the utmost priority at the parade. Riders and drivers are expected to use significant caution when participating in the parade.
- Each parade participant must wear and display the wristband provided by the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show before entering the parade route and as requested by parade officials.
- > ANY FIREARMS CARRIED IN THE PARADE ARE SUBJECT TO ALL APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS.
- Acknowledging history and the role Texas played in the secession of the original seven Confederate states from the Union, the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo requires that any Confederate flag used in an official Stock Show activity such as the parade, grand entry, and merchandise sales be limited to the original National Flag of the Confederacy.
- > The distribution, throwing, posting or displaying of any advertisement, pamphlet, flyer or any other item will not, under any circumstance, be permitted by anyone.
- No alcoholic beverages permitted in staging area or during parade.
- > No motorized vehicles.
- > No open/contained fires or firebox devices.
- > No double or backward horseback riding; no animals tethered to other animals, wagons, or floats; no riders on lead lines permitted.
- **Do not slow or stop forward progress of the parade**. Participants must follow instructions of parade marshals at all times.
- ➤ Only saddle or draft horses, mules or donkeys allowed. <u>NO DOGS</u>, llamas or any animal other than a saddle or draft horse, donkey or mule are allowed in the parade.
- Only six outriders permitted per horse-drawn vehicle in a Float / Horse Drawn Vehicle entry.
- ➤ Horseback riders entered as a Riding Club or Sheriff Posse must be an <u>organized club with a minimum of 8 members participating</u> (no independent riders).
- Stock Show management reserves the right to deny participation or remove from parade any exhibit, person, animal, wagon or other entry that may be falsely entered or may be deemed unsuitable or objectionable, without assigning reason thereof.



Exposition and Livestock Show Participant also recognizes that it will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage to, or occasioned by, arising from, any horse or other livestock used by the Participant or present at the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, including the preparation, duration and disbanding of said Show and any parts thereof. Each Exposition and Livestock Show Participant further agrees to execute such releases or other writings or other documents which evidence Participant's acknowledgment and understanding of the foregoing release and indemnity, provided, however, the provisions hereof shall prevail in the event that a conflict or other inconsistency is discovered regarding the contents of this provision, and any release executed by a Participant. Further, participants grant permission to the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show and their designees to use participant's image or likeness in connection with any broadcast or other reproduction of this event.

UNDER TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 87, CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE), A LIVESTOCK SHOW SPONSOR IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO, OR THE DEATH OF, A PARTICIPANT IN A LIVESTOCK SHOW RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES.

PARKING LOT LOCATION MAPS







NEW ARRIVAL PROCEDURES TO PARKING AREAS


DIRECTIONS TO RED LOT:

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HORSES (And Other Equine)

TEXAS ORIGIN

A) Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test, also known as a "Coggins" Test, within the past twelve (12) months.

OUT OF STATE ORIGIN

- A) Original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within thirty (30) days.
- B) Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test, also known as a "Coggins" Test, within the past twelve (12) months. Test date, accession number and name of laboratory must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Exemption:

Equine may enter the All-Western Parade and staging area without a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection when accompanied by a valid equine interstate passport or equine identification card and a completed VS Form 10-11 showing negative results to an official EIA test within the previous six (6) months.

Humane Treatment. Humane treatment of animals (including helping horses) must be exercised at all times by all exhibitors and their employees. Animals that have been given any form of intoxicating beverages, tranquilizers or other drugs enhancing the performance, or affecting the mood or attitude of the animal prior to judging will be disqualified. Any inhumane treatment will be reported to the appropriate governing association.

Diseased Animals Barred. Efforts will be taken to ensure no animal(s) having a disease of any character will be admitted into the All-Western Parade or its staging areas at any time, and the Parade Chairman, Parade Veterinarian, or Stock Show President are authorized to refuse unloading privileges or remove any animal on the parade premises having a disease or undesirable ailment as determined by the official Stock Show Veterinarian or the Texas Animal Health Commission.

2023 ALL-WESTERN PARADE APPLICATION RIDING CLUBS / SHERIFF'S POSSES, continued

I (we) understand and agree to the following:

- 1) I (we) agree to obtain health papers on all horses and other equine entering the All-Western Parade in accordance with the Health Requirements for Horses and Other Equine set forth in the Official Health Requirements of the parade application.
- 2) I (we) understand that should one or more horse or other equine in the same trailer fail to meet the standards of the Official Health Requirements, ALL horses or other equine in the trailer will be refused entrance to the parade and staging area.
- 3) I (we) understand that my (our) application to participate as a Riding Club or Sheriff's Posse <u>does not</u> <u>permit musical instruments or individuals walking</u> as part of this entry request.
- 4) I (we) have the minimum of eight (8) members required to participate as a Riding Club or Sheriff's Posse in the parade.
- 5) I (we) agree to move at the pace of the parade and will not slow or stop forward progress of the parade.

Health Requirements for Horses and Other Equine are attached.

- 6) That ALL health papers will be checked before entering parade or parade staging area. Any horse or other equine without papers will not be permitted to enter the parade or parade staging area. Should one or more horse or other equine in the same trailer fail to meet the standards of the Official Health Requirements, ALL horses or other equine in the trailer will be refused entrance to the parade and staging area. I (we) further understand that the health papers are to be in my possession at all times.
- 7) That if my (our) application to participate is for a Riding Club or Sheriff's Posse, there are **no musical instruments or individuals walking permitted** as part of the entry request.
- 8) To have the minimum of eight (8) members required to participate as a Riding Club or Sheriff's Posse in the parade.
- 9) To move at the pace of the parade and will not slow or stop forward progress of the parade.

Health Requirements for Horses and Other Equine

All equine must show proof of a negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) "Coggins" test within the past twelve (12) months. Out of State equine must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection not more than THIRTY (30) days old at the time of arrival issued by a licensed veterinarian. Test date, accession number and name of laboratory must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Exemption: Equine may enter shows, fairs, exhibitions, or assemblies without a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection when accompanied by a valid equine interstate passport or equine identification card and a completed VS Form 10-11 showing negative results to an official EIA test within the previous six (6) months.
