RULES AND REGULATIONS

All contestants will be under the supervision of the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, and all Horse Show General Rules and Regulations in the Horse Show *Premium List* of this Show and the Horse Show Department will apply unless otherwise stated in the Cala de Caballo Rules of 2020-24 as indicated in the Federación Mexicana de Charrería. Each exhibitor, participant or other individual or entity participating in any aspect of the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, including without limitation, livestock and animal entrants, grand entry participants, and Charro Competition participants (collectively, "Exposition and Livestock Show Participants") including any of their heirs, dependents, assigns, agents or representatives in any capacity, hereby waives all rights and claims for damages, and do hereby agree to release, hold harmless and unconditionally indemnify the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, sponsors, and co-producers of any Exposition and Livestock Show events, and any officials or employees, thereof, from and against all liability, costs, expenses, claims and damages, even if caused by the alleged negligence or gross negligence of the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, which the Exposition and Livestock Show Participant, or the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show may at any time suffer or sustain or become liable for by reason of any accidents, damages, injuries or incidents either to the person or property, or both, or the Exposition and Livestock Show Participant, or of any other parties, in any manner arising from such Participant's participation in any Exposition and Livestock Show event or at any Exposition and Livestock Show premises which is in any way connected with the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, its officers, directors, members, agents, sponsors or employees. Exposition and Livestock Show Participant also recognizes that it will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage to, or occasioned by, arising from, any horse or other livestock used by the Participant or present at the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, including the preparation, duration and disbanding of said Show and any parts thereof. Each Exposition and Livestock Show Participant further agrees to execute such releases or other writings or other documents which evidence Participant's acknowledgement and understanding of the foregoing release and indemnity, provided, however, the provisions hereof shall prevail in the event that a conflict or other inconsistency is discovered regarding the contents of this provision, and any release executed by a Participant. Further, Exposition and Livestock Show Participant grants permission to the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show and their designees to use Exposition and Livestock Show Participant's image or likeness in connection with any broadcast or other reproduction of this event.

1. Entries in the 2023 Youth Charro Cala Competition are open to youth, ages 14-18, as of January 1, 2023. Entries will be accepted online at fwssr.com or at the Stock Show Main Office located in the Amon G. Carter Jr. Exhibits Hall building. Entries are limited to the first 10 applicants.
2. **ENTRY FEE. \$150 (non-refundable)**
3. **STALL FEE.** No stall fee charged on January 27th, 28th, 29th & 30th. Stalls must be vacated by noon on January 30.
4. **FORMAT.** The Charro Cala will consist of ten (10) Caladors, one qualifying round and a final round of the top five (5) performers. Scored components will consist of a slide. Competition will adhere to the rules of the Federación Mexicana de Charrería, including a time limit of 5 minutes to get in position and slide. The official language will be Spanish and English. In the event of a tie, there will only be one (1) tiebreaker elimination and determined by two criteria: (1) competitor with the lowest negative points and (2) competitor with the greatest number of extra points during the slide and with the shortest time mark.
5. **REGISTRATION.** All Competition registration materials must be postmarked or submitted online by November 15, 2022. The registration materials will consist of the following:
 - a. Entry and Waiver Form
 - b. Photo and Profile Form

6. **PARKING.** Exhibitors with vehicles pulling trailers will be directed to an appropriate parking location by Stock Show staff and will remain on Stock Show grounds at staff's discretion. However, no trailer, vehicle or vehicle/trailer combination will be allowed to remain on Stock Show grounds overnight. **Any trailer, vehicle or vehicle/trailer combinations left overnight will be towed at owner's expense. No overnight camping on the Stock Show grounds. NO RV HOOKUPS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR HORSE SHOW EXHIBITORS.**
7. **HEALTH RULES. Must have to enter Show Grounds.**

Texas Origin

- A. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within **thirty (30) days.**
- B. Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test, also known as a "Coggins" Test, within the past twelve (12) months. Test date, accession number and name of laboratory must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

A copy of current Coggins Test must be sent in with entry application at time of entry.

Exemption: Equine may enter shows, fairs, exhibitions or assemblies without a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection when accompanied by a valid equine interstate passport or equine identification card and a completed VS Form 10-11 showing negative results to an official EIA test within the previous six (6) months.

Out of State Origin

- A. Horses must meet the same requirements as Texas origin horses.

8. **HUMANE TREATMENT.** Humane treatment of animals (including helping horses) must be exercised at all times by all exhibitors and their employees. Animals that have been given any form of intoxicating beverages, tranquilizers or other drugs enhancing the performance, or affecting the mood or attitude of the animal prior to judging will be disqualified. Any inhumane treatment will be reported to the appropriate governing association.
9. **ARRIVAL DATES.** Contestants and their horses may arrive on the grounds on Friday, January 27. Horses will be released after completion of contest.
10. **CHECK IN.** Each contestant must be present at 6:00 pm on January 27 to be granted arena practice time on Friday night. Practice times will be assigned prior to the competition and each Calador will be notified once all registration materials are accepted. Each Calador will have 10 minutes to practice.
11. **PERFORMANCE ORDER.** The performance order for each performance (qualifying round and top five finals) will be determined by a random draw. The performance order for the top five finals will be announced at completion of the first round inside the Coliseum upon completion of the video review and tabulation.
12. **PHOTO AND PROFILE FORM.** Each Calador must complete the attached profile form and submit a photograph via email to dora@tovarpr.com. This information is for competition publicity and promotions purposes.
