Sellars wins \$4,400 in bull riding at Fort Worth's Pro Rodeo Tournament Sunday

FORT WORTH, Texas (Jan. 23, 2022)— Clayton Sellars of Wildwood, Florida, was the only cowboy to make a qualified ride Sunday afternoon at the 2022 edition of the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo's (FWSSR) Pro Rodeo Tournament.

Sellars scored 82.5 points and earned \$4,400 for his efforts. He has virtually cinched a berth in the tournament semifinals, which goes to the two top money winners in each event for each set of competitors. Sellars simply needs to get on his bull Monday night to advance, since he has already wrapped up half of the available winnings in his set.

Since winning the 2018 bull riding rookie of the year title, Sellars has qualified for three National Finals Rodeos (NFR), finishing sixth last season. He also was the reserve champion of the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) Xtreme Bulls division in 2021. Sellars, now 23, followed his father, older brother and cousin into bull riding beginning at age 7. Three trips to the National High School Finals Rodeo and two trips to the College National Finals Rodeo followed with Sellars finishing as college reserve champion in 2018.

Three-time world champion Hailey Kinsel of Cotulla and her superstar mare DM Sissy Hayday (Sister) won Sunday's round of barrel racing, stopping the clock in 16.67. This was Kinsel's first run on Sister in more than a month since the final round of the NFR in Las Vegas. Jimmie Smith of McDade was second with a 16.72. Smith, the 2018 barrel racing rookie of the year, qualified for the 2020 NFR and barely missed a second qualification last year.

Sunday's rodeo began the second set of competition. Fifty-six of the top rodeo athletes in North America compete in each of eight events for more than \$1.1 million dollars prize money. Sunday's athletes compete again Monday night at 7:30 at Dickies Arena.
