



90 – 100 Excellent equitation, position and presentation; meets all fences squarely and at a proper distance; Uses all options to their advantage.

70-79 More problems occur, equitation suffers, i.e., rounded shoulders, heels are not down, hands incorrect, lacks the style and presence. One major fence problem, i.e., chip with a ride up the neck, discreet swap out or jumping off one side of jump.No dangerous fences but not a flowing course.

40 – 59 Breaking to a trot while on course, counter canter or cross canter ends of arena, missed lead changes, loss of stirrup, drop a rein, extra stride in combination.
