Breakaway Roper Dominates FWSSR PRORODEO Tournament

FORT WORTH, TEXAS, (Jan. 26, 2024) --- Consistency is key for rodeo contestants hoping to win titles at the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo's PRORODEO Tournament. Nowhere has that been more evident than with Texas breakaway roper Jordi Evans in bracket 4.

Edens who lives at Gatesville has been the most consistent woman to rope so far at this year's rodeo. She won round one of bracket 4 with a 2.1-second run on Thursday night. Then she stopped the clock in exactly the same time in round two during Friday's matinee to win again.

Contestants advance from the brackets to the Semi-Finals here based on total money won. With her two first-place finishes, Edens has already collected \$4,000 and if she keeps it up, she stands to earn substantially more.

Jordi joined the Women's Professional Rodeo Association in 2021 and qualified for her first Wrangler National Finals Breakaway Roping the next year. She missed the event by a few spots in 2023, finishing 18th. She is working hard to be among the top 15 that compete for world championships this year and a big win here in Fort Worth would certainly help her.

In the tie-down roping, local athlete Cole Clemens from Lipan showed the fans that he is here to stay. Clemens won the National High School Finals Rodeo representing Florida in 2021. He came to Texas to attend Parker County's Weatherford College and compete in the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association.

He is in his first full year of competition in the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association and is vying for the Rookie of the Year title as well. Clemens is making strides to accomplishing his goals in Dickies Arena.

The clock stopped at 7.9 seconds in round 2 to give him the win on Friday afternoon. That added \$2,000 to the \$1,000 he pocketed for third in round one and earned him a spot in next week's Semi-Finals.
