The Joshua M. Freeman Foundation, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, was established in 2007 to honor Josh Freeman, the former Chair of the Carl M. Freeman Companies, after his untimely death in December of 2006. The Foundation seeks to honor Josh's passion and commitment to excellence by creating programs he would have been proud of. These programs include Freeman Arts Pavilion, an outdoor performance venue near Fenwick Island, which presents over 60 performances a year, and our Arts Access Initiative, which provides K-12 students and underserved families of Delmarva year-round access to high-quality, diverse arts experiences at no cost. Annually, more than 80,000 residents and visitors are impacted through our mission of advancing arts access for all through performance, education and advocacy.

A LETTER FROM MICHELLE FREEMAN

The last two seasons have been a transformative time for our organization. Not only was 2021 the inaugural year of our newly rebranded outdoor venue – from The Freeman Stage to Freeman Arts Pavilion — but the challenge of bringing the arts to Delmarva while navigating the COVID-19 pandemic was tremendous. Our 14th season as a public charity performing arts venue included ongoing changes to health restrictions.

Despite all that, more than 81,000 patrons crossed our entrance to safely enjoy the live performances all summer. Patrons enjoyed over 65 diverse arts programs, including the return of national recording artists, and were able to create ever-lasting memories once again with their friends, families and neighbors.

Through it all, we have been reminded of the importance of the arts on not only individuals, but the community at large. In 2021, Freeman Arts Pavilion contributed over \$16.5 million in economic impact to Sussex County and the surrounding area while safely bringing the community together and increasing the quality of life for residents and guests.

The successes of this season would not have been possible without the support of our patrons, sponsors, donors and volunteers. They were instrumental by being patient, enthusiastic and supportive. On behalf of the entire organization, I extend our heartfelt gratitude to each and every one of you — we look forward to continued partnership and unwavering encouragement.

Introducing the

FREEMAN ARTS PAVILION



In 2021, The Freeman Stage became Freeman Arts Pavilion. Along with the rest of the world, we watched the pandemic stretch into another year. While we were proud of the special season of the arts that we accomplished in 2020, we knew it was not feasible to continue in the space that had served us so well for 13 seasons. Instead, we broke ground on the new venue that would allow us to safely accommodate patrons and also present diverse and high-quality performances.

The vision for Freeman Arts Pavilion, transformed into a multi-phase plan, and in 2021 featured a Grand Green that could accommodate roughly 500 seating pods, a Lower Lawn where patrons could enjoy pre-performance food and drinks, an expanded entry at the Main Gate and additional restroom and concession areas throughout the venue.





We pressed play on the 2021 season with a sold-out performance by Kashmir: The Live Led Zeppelin Show on June 17. For the next 14 weeks, more than 81,000 patrons, many of whom had not been to a live arts performance since 2019, delighted in the aspects of the venue and enjoyed a few hours of music and fun under the stars.

ARTS ACCESS INITIATIVE

While some schools returned to in-person learning in the 2020-2021 school year, many teachers and parents were still navigating the challenges of virtual and hybrid learning. We partnered with local artist, John Donato, and created our newest Arts in Education project, "Creative Nourishment Kits." The kits helped fill the void of arts education programs and reached more than 30,880 students in Sussex, Kent and Worcester counties. We also partnered with Hip Hop Fundamentals, an award-winning team of diverse professional break-dancers dedicated to Hip Hop education. The team created instructional videos for more than 10,000 students. Free children and family programming were also showcased at the venue with theatre, dance, cultural performances, magic shows and classical events.

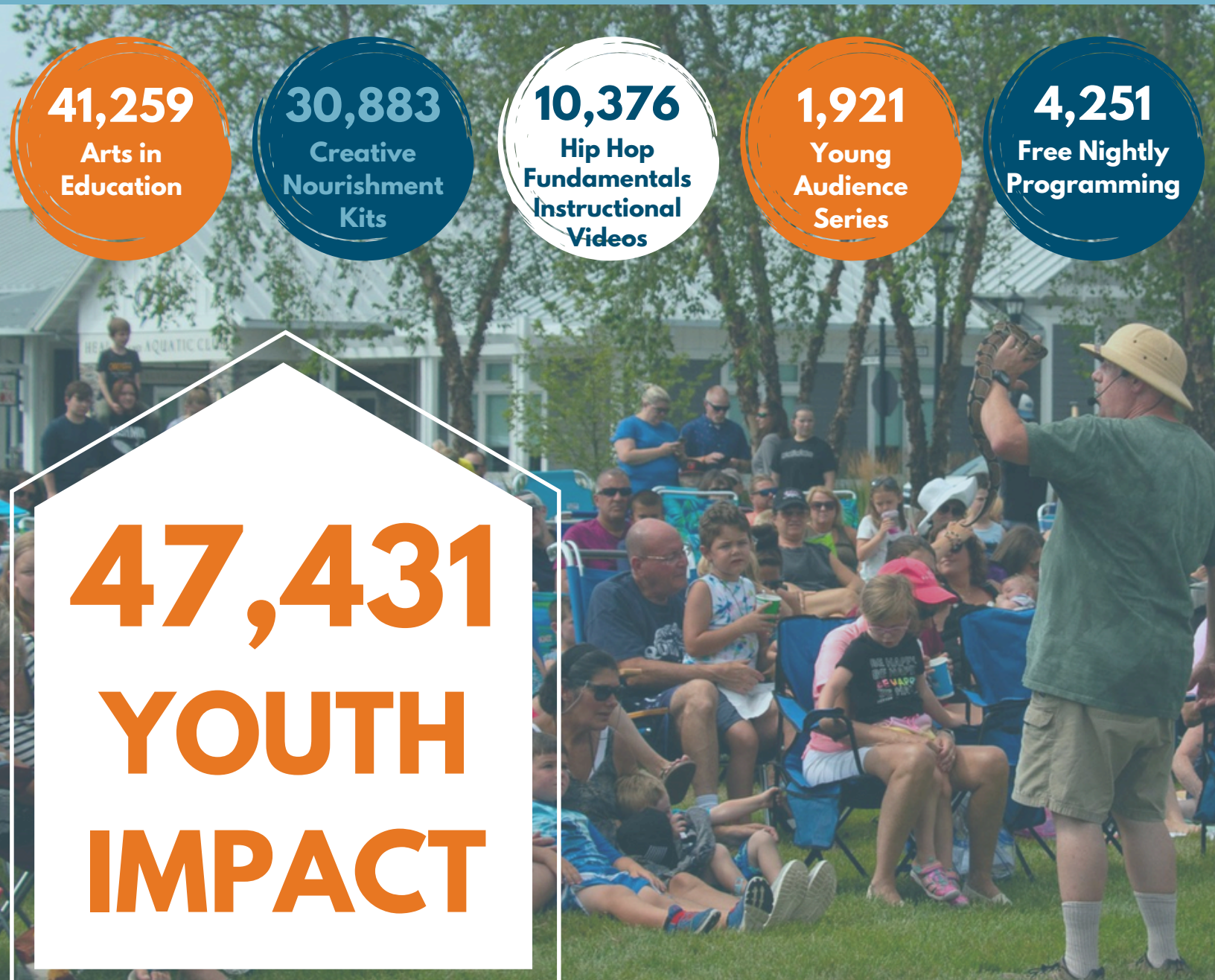

Since 2008 the support of the community through sponsorship, donations and volunteerism has allowed us to provide arts access to the Mid-Atlantic region.

A generous group of nearly 450 sponsors, trusted our vision for the future and the new venue and provided monetary support in 2021.

Other fundraising efforts included the 15th Annual Joshua M. Freeman Foundation Golf Tournament on October 2, Giving Tuesday (the global day of giving) on November 30 and our Inspiring Joy Year-End Campaign, with all 3 efforts garnering record-breaking contributions.

We are grateful for everyone who has donated their time, talent or treasure that has allowed us to continue to create opportunities that elevate the human spirit.

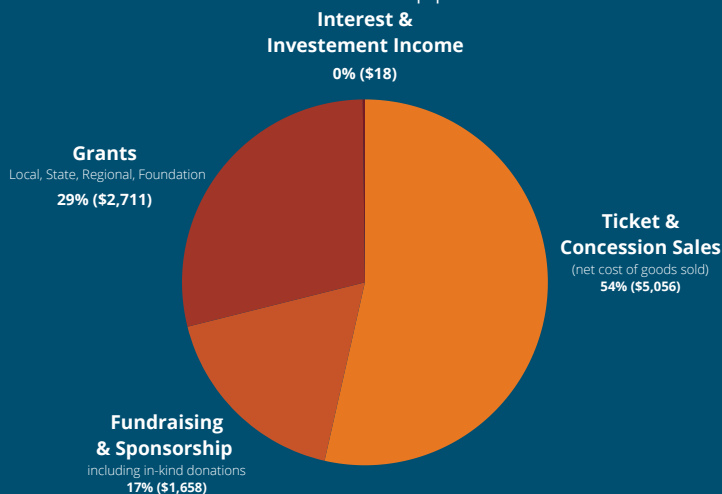


OUR IMPACT

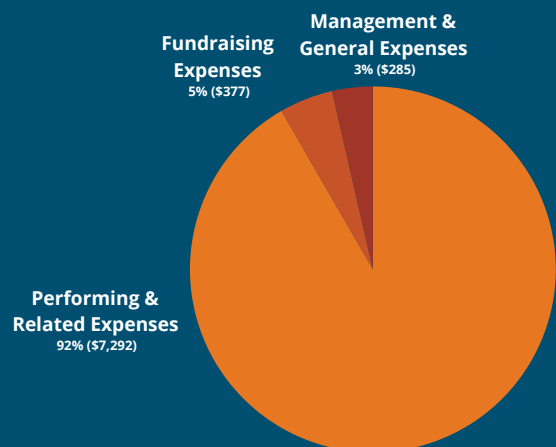
Revenue & Support

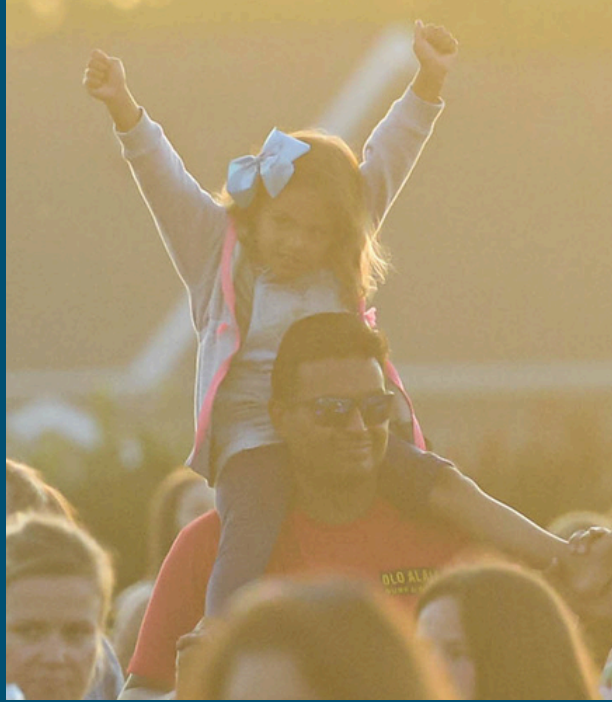
