

## **Fremont County Fair Ambassador Code of Conduct Guidelines**

The purpose of the Fremont County Fair Ambassador is to promote the Fremont County Fair, to develop positive relationships among fair participants, and to create a rapport between the community and the Fremont County Fair. Fair Ambassadors are a leader and a representative of the Fremont County Fair.

When you become a Fremont County Fair Ambassador, the Ambassador Committee, Fair Staff and Fair Board expect that you not only understand your leadership role, but also are willing to accept responsibilities that go with that role. The contributions you make should be a rewarding accomplishment for you and your family. The most important of these responsibilities is to broaden yourself and develop a deep pride in our Fair, Fremont County, and Wyoming.

By participating as a Fremont County Fair Ambassador, you are representing the reputation of our fair. Your title reflects leadership. As a leader you are a part of the flagship of our Fair. You are often the first impression for the public and you will be in the spotlight during your reign. The fair participants and the community judge our fair by your conduct and attitudes. Because of your leadership role, you can contribute greatly to community pride. Make Fremont County proud of you, and your community proud of our fair!

### A. Guidelines.

1. If guidelines are not followed during the reign the result will be that the Ambassador involved will be removed from the Fremont County Fair Ambassador Team.
2. Any actions by Ambassadors that are detrimental to the integrity of the Fremont County Fair, shall constitute removal from the team.

### B. Fremont County Fair Ambassadors must be leaders. You are an representative of the Fremont County Fair. You are expected to:

1. Exhibit respect for others.
2. Abstain from use of illegal substances or conduct unbecoming of your position.
3. If you are of legal age, use of alcohol and tobacco while representing the Fremont County Fair and/or wearing your official dress will constitute basis for removal. As a leader if you are arrested or charged with illegal actions, you will

be required to come before a review panel composed of Ambassador Committee members and representatives of the Fair Board. The decision of the board is final.

5. During the duration of your reign, if traveling while representing the Fremont County Fair, such travel, if a minor, will occur only with approved chaperones.

C. Rules remain in effect for the duration of your reign. This term begins the first day of March and continues until August 31, 2022.

D. Violations

1. The Ambassador involved and parents of minors will meet with the Fair Manager, Fair Board members, and a representative of the Ambassador Committee.
2. Ambassadors will be in violation of the leadership rules whenever participating in or supporting illegal actions.
3. Review of violation may result in suspension or termination of your reign. All representative gifts and equipment shall be returned upon termination.

E. Reapplying to compete in succeeding Fremont County Fair Ambassador Programs.

1. In order to run for Fremont County Fair Ambassador in successive years a participant that has been removed from a position shall complete a special application to the Fair Board which will be reviewed on an individual basis.
