



Cruising to the Souldies Hosted by Danny Trejo Table Mountain Concert Series Presented by Modelo Especial & Toyota

“Cruising to the Souldies” – Hosted by Danny Trejo featuring Trish Toldedo and Frankie J, with special guests Cota and Danny’s Angels is on Saturday, October 8 at 7 p.m. at The Big Fresno Fair as part of The Table Mountain Concert Series presented by Modelo Especial and Toyota!

This specially curated show is guaranteed to have you moving and grooving. Hosted by beloved actor and entrepreneur Danny Trejo, this show features Trish Toledo whose style melds 1960s soul with early 1970s music. Trish’s musical influences are Aretha Franklin, Barbra Mason and Brenton Wood, which is reflective in her style. Trish Toledo, described as a music time traveler, reinvests brilliant pop and soul ballads from the early sixties with modern fire and fortitude, on her debut album release, *Dedicated to the Ones I Love Vol. 1*; Trish breathes new life into classic repertoire. She has practiced and developed her musical skills since childhood and has continued to record and release music, currently working towards her fourth release.

Also featured is former Frankie J, who has collaborated with Trish on several songs. Frankie J is known for his fusion of R&B and Latin sounds, recording hits in both English and Spanish. Frankie J’s 2003 debut solo single, “Don’t Wanna Try,” went Top 20 on the Billboard Hot 100 pop chart. Also in 2003, Frankie guested on rapper Baby Bash’s 10 pop hit “Suga, Suga.” The duo recreated the chemistry on Frankie’s 2005 smash “Obsession (No Es Amor),” which climbed to No. 3. “Obsession” appears on Frankie J’s third album, 2005’s *The One*, which reached No. 3 on the Billboard 200 and went platinum. That same year, Frankie notched another Top 40 pop hit with his cover of the rock band Extreme’s 1991 hit “More Than Words.” Frankie J’s seventh album, *Faith, Hope Y Amor*, was nominated for Best Latin Pop Album at the 2014 Grammy Awards. It lost to Draco Rosa’s *Vida*. In 2017, Frankie and Baby Bash partnered for the album *Sangria*.

The show will also showcase singer, songwriter and guitarist, Cota, who has opened shows for both classic soul artists and hard-edged hip-hop creators like The Game and Tyga. His voice sings with a smooth, angelic vocal tone that is reminiscent of the R&B greats who have influenced his craft. Then lastly, the show will showcase up and coming artists, Danny’s Angels, who consist of singers, Tarah New, Twixxy, and Amora.

Danny Trejo has developed a prolific career in the entertainment industry with a hard-earned and atypical road to success. From years of imprisonment to helping troubled youth battle drug additions, from acting to producing and now on to restaurant ventures, Trejo’s name, face, and achievements are well-recognized in Hollywood and beyond. Trejo has starred in films like *Machete*, *Machete Kills*, *Desperado*, *Heat*, the *From Dusk till Dawn* series, *Once Upon A Time In Mexico*, the *Spy Kids* movies, and many more. He has had recurring roles on *Sons of Anarchy*, *King of the Hill*, *Breaking Bad*, and *The Flash* to name a few. When Trejo is not on screen, he is getting his hands in other hustles, like recently expanding his Trejo’s Tacos empire in Los Angeles area, as well as Trejo’s Coffee & Donuts. Danny also



plays continuous roles as a devoted father of three and an intervention counselor. Danny's colorful life and prolific career are chronicled in the latest bio-documentary *Inmate #1: The Rise of Danny Trejo*.
