OF THE EXHIBITORS HANDBOOK  
ALL STATE RULES APPLY EXCEPT WHERE NOTED

**ELIGIBILITY** Open to Communities and Organizations

### Feature Exhibits

1. State Rule 8-8 does not apply to booth exhibitors.
2. The Niagara Chemical Company will award a Perpetual Trophy to the Community Exhibit for the best decorated and animated booth. An exhibitor must win the trophy three consecutive times before permanent possession may be claimed.
3. The Fresno County Farm Bureau will award a Perpetual Trophy to the Community Exhibit having the most original booth displaying the Agricultural Theme. An exhibitor must win the trophy three consecutive times before permanent possession can be claimed.
4. The Big Fresno Fair will award: a Perpetual Trophy to the Community Exhibit winning the sweepstakes award in each of the following divisions:

At least 600 sq. ft. or greater  
At least 301-599 sq. ft.  
At least 300 sq. ft or less

All Community Exhibits in the Variety Feature Exhibits and the Special Feature Exhibits compete together in each division. An exhibitor must win the trophy three consecutive times before permanent possession maybe claimed.

Displaying the diversity of agricultural produce and the uniqueness of each community in a manner most interesting to the public through the use of readable labeling, concise legends, and other visual or audio education aids using a minimum of brand names.

**QUALITY** ..... 20%  
Excellence of quality in produce displayed as determined by market standards. Immature or overripe produce reduces the quality.

**DECORATION, ARRANGEMENT & LIGHTING** 10%  
Effective use of articles of produce, color, lighting and animation which attracts attention and presents a pleasing appearance. Attractive arrangement and proper grouping of commodities to achieve well-balanced harmony. Effective use of all space allotted.

**THEME** ..... 10%  
Thought or idea, expressed by design feature of the exhibit (unless specifically required, the theme used must be the current year theme).

**VARIETY** ..... 20%

**Total 100%**

INDIGENOUS NON-CULTIVATED PLANTS AND TREES OR THEIR PRODUCTS, FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTAL PLANTS, SHALL NOT BE COUNTED, EXCEPT WHEN THE FLOWERS ARE COMMERCIAL CROP IN THE AREA REPRSENTED.

Special Feature Exhibit Booths shall display an agricultural product, process or procedure of the area represented in such a manner as to most attractively inform the public of the value, desirability and interest to the consumer, to be found in the subject being featured.

Cleverness & skill in design and/or contrivances used to illustrate or represent, such as miniatures, diagrams, photographs, lighting, models, etc. Should adhere to scale. Inconspicuous detail not required.

#### **ATTRACTIVENESS                    25%**

Effective use of composition, animation, color and/or other exhibit aids to enhance appearance, create interest and invite closer inspection.

#### **COMPLETENESS                        10%**

Includes all important aspects or components of the booth subject or theme and utilizes to best advantage all of the space allotted.

## **AGRICULTURE-HORTICULTURE**

The quality desired in agricultural and horticultural products exhibits is the quality that brings the best financial return in the commercial market, and such exhibits must be at least equal in maturity as the stage of ripeness required by section 42513 of the California Agricultural Code in order to be considered for cash awards. The stage of ripeness is further defined as being available for nearby markets. Exhibits stressing features which detract from the commercial value of any product are undesirable and should be avoided.

## **LOCAL RULES**

1. Free cold storage for perishables will be furnished in the Cold Storage Building on the Fairgrounds. Individual space will be provided for each community. **Fruit must be in clean boxes, plainly marked on end with exhibitor's name and must be lidded and cleated for stacking.** Available Sept. 8th.
2. Judges book will be used as evidence of payment of cash awards.
3. Any entry not properly listed will not be judged.
4. Display plates will be furnished by the Fair Management. All entries will remain on display for the duration of the Fair.
5. **Any spoiled products must be removed and replaced with fresh products.**
6. Each entry in this Department must be plainly labeled. Exhibitor's tags will be provided by the management.
7. For guidance of the exhibitor the following rules are factors which the judges usually consider in placing awards:
  - a Condition of fruit (free from insects, injury, blemishes and disease).
  - b Quality of the product
  - c Form (typical of variety)
  - d Size desired by commercial use
  - e Neatness of package (nailing, alignment and cleanliness)
8. All products must be produced and grown within the community or district placing the exhibit.
9. Exhibitors of plate and/or crate displays (feature only) may not present more than two plates and/or crates of any one variety at the time of judging.
10. All products and decorations must be kept within the booth.
11. Rack displays shall be in group specified in exhibitor's book, but can be shown in any arrangement with the face visible for judge's inspection.
12. If current season's agriculture and horticulture products are immature or not fully developed in size, then past season's products will be used.
13. All fruits and vegetables to be judged must be in booth at the start of judging and must not be removed until the close of judging.
14. Any frozen fruit or vegetables coming into the judging stands will be disqualified.
15. All orange and lemon rack containers may consist of 5-pound polyethylene bags. All grapefruit rack containers may consist of 8-pound polyethylene bags.
16. Sweepstakes shall be awarded for grapes (rack and feature displays) with points to be counted as follows:

1st Award 5 points each package in racks and features

2nd Award 3 points each package in racks and features

3rd Award 1 point each package in racks and features
