

CODE OF CONDUCT

21st District Agricultural Association / DBA "The Big Fresno Fair"

In an effort to improve The Big Fresno Fair experience for patrons, the Fair has developed a Code of Conduct including 10 common-sense guidelines intended to foster a safe and comfortable atmosphere for all guests.

Any violation of the following Code of Conduct could subject violators to ejection or arrest at The Big Fresno Fair. In order to ensure a safe and celebratory environment, we ask that patrons refrain from the following behavior at The Big Fresno Fair:

- 1. Profanity or other offensive language, whether spoken or appearing on apparel
- 2. Smoking. The Fair is a non-smoking facility with the exception of designated smoking areas. This includes marijuana and vaping
- 3. Intoxication or excessive alcohol consumption
- 4. Bringing prohibited items into the venue
- 5. Throwing of items or liquids
- 6. Entering restricted areas
- 7. Fighting or other threatening behavior
- 8. Failure to retain ticket and/or present it to event staff if requested to do so. This includes the Weekend Admission Policy of wearing a designated wristband at all times on Friday and Saturday nights
- 9. Resale of tickets at the venue
- 10. Violation of state or local laws

Failure to comply may subject you to ejection or arrest. Guests are encouraged to report inappropriate behavior to team/venue personnel. We welcome your help in our efforts to provide an enjoyable experience for all guests.
