The Table Mountain Concert Series Will Not Be Part of This Year's Modified Big Fresno Fair Event

The Fair continues collaboration with the Health Department to determine what elements of this tradition can still be brought to the community

FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, July 13, 2020...The popular Table Mountain Concert Series presented by Coors Light and Toyota in the Paul Paul Theater will not be part of the modified 2020 Big Fresno Fair. The Fair has been working with the Fresno County Department of Public Health on a satisfactory plan for concerts, however the Health Department decided it would not approve concerts in the Paul Paul Theater at the 2020 Fair event.

For those individuals who had purchased concert tickets to one of the four announced 2020 shows (Becky G, Ezra Ray Hart, Frankie Valli & The Four Seasons and The Isley Brothers), refunds will automatically be issued to the credit card the tickets were purchased on.
