ITEM #11. EXECUTIVE STAFF REPORT: (Informational)

a. Report on Satellite Racing/CARF Meeting:

Satellite Supervisor Ruben Gastelo reported the handle is up marginally and attendance and ADW are both slightly down. The Pegasus Race ran January 28th, and our handle was up, and attendance was down. Also reported that the Satellite department will be having a handicapping contested in March and will give out prizes. Additionally, we have started to prepare for the triple crown racing series and Satellite racing will move back to the grandstand in May. Satellite Supervisor also reported that he reached out to the mutual union president to discuss getting more tellers at the Fair and has discussed the topic of bet runners for box seats holders. They are working to see if this is possibility feasible. CEO King reported that there is a lot of movement with live racing dates in the industry. Our Fair dates are secure, but others are trying to get dates overlapped for the Humboldt Race track.

b. Report on Interim Events:

Event Coordinator Taylor Childers reported that this weekend we have our March Home Show which is our largest Home Show, and your tickets are with your Board packet. Also reported that the National Garlic Festival will not be putting on their event in 2023 but plan to come back in 2024. This left a weekend open in May for the entire grounds and we are looking at producing a Monster Truck Show and Carnival with Butler Amusements and will put the event ourselves. Director Flores asked about the cashless option for the Home Show, Event Coordinator Childers stated that we will be debuting the credit card machines in the parking lot for the Home Show. CEO King stated that we want to see if this is a way to go cashless in the parking lots during the Fair. The machines will take cash and credit. For interim events we cannot require cashless because they are not our events but for the Fair, we can go cashless. Childers reported that the Home Show does not take credit cards at the gates. Childers is also working on the Hmong New Year bid and hoping to have that bid out in a few weeks.

We have a lot of requests for interim events and both Taylor and Ruben are answering inquiries.

c. Report on Preliminary 2020 Financial Audit:

CEO King stated that the audit was included in your Board packet. While we have focused on the compliance audit, we also had the financial audit, and we did not have any questions on their findings. The Audit Office will make it a final draft and it will be released from there. CEO King asked if any Board members had any questions on the audit.

ITEM #12. COMMITTEE REPORTS: (Action by the Board)

A. <u>Finance Committee</u>:

President Gonsalves recommended handling all 3 items in one motion.

MSP (Pacheco - Perea) to approve the December 31, 2022, and January 31, 2023, Check Registers, Statement of Operations and Balance Sheets. The vote was unanimous.

Director Flores asked why in December and January we were being charged bank fees with Central Valley Community Bank. CEO King explained that when we moved the majority of our money to the money market account it brought our operating accounts to a lower amount which caused us to be charged bank fees. She had the Bank look into this and with the interest we are making in the money market account we are still significantly money ahead. We are both monitoring the fees. Director Flores expressed his concerns that for the money we have in the bank we should not be paying so much in fees. President Gonsalves asked what the balance is we must keep to not have fees. CEO King stated that she would find out on the amount. Director Flores also asked for clarification on the CalPERS payments where we make a payment then we get charged late fees.

Accounting Supervisor Cinnamon Howell reported that we have been fighting fees and penalties with CalPERS and that to stay in good standing we pay all the late fees or penalties and then dispute them. CEO King also pointed out that it is a new format for the check register and explanation. This new format is generated from the system not manually inputted like the previous one.

ITEM #13. OLD BUSINESS: (Informational/Action by the Board)

a. <u>Discussion on Revenue Generating Ideas:</u>

Director Flores and Director Chahil brought up the idea of sponsorship levels from the previous meeting. CEO King reported that the supporting sponsorship program sheet was in their packets and asked if anyone had any questions. Director Riojas reported he is going to ask for donations from his organization, but they do not want the tickets.

b. <u>Discussion on possible cashless options:</u>

CEO King explained that we are moving forward with cashless and currently working with the company with the cash to card converting machines to have them on the calendar for October.

c. <u>Discussion on Strategic Planning</u>

CEO King explained that this should have been included in your packets, but it was not. This is the proposal for the strategic planning and after the Board has time to review would like to move forward with selecting dates. King asked the Board to get back to her with thoughts and available dates.

ITEM #14. NEW BUSINESS: (Action by the Board)

a. <u>Approval of Asphalt Project to be managed by California Construction</u>
<u>Authority (CCA)</u>

MSP (Flores-Chahil) to approve the agreement for asphalt project to be managed by California Construction Authority (CCA).

CEO King explained that when you have a major construction project on a Fairgrounds over \$500,000 then you must use CCA. CCA will manage our proposed asphalt project and have it completed in our quick time frame which is May 1st. CEO King indicated that with their project management there is a fee and feels that the fee is worthwhile. They will take this project from start to finish.

CEO King reported that the area that we are looking at repaving is from the grandstand to the Butler gate. The Fair is in a great financial situation to spend about \$750,000 on this project. By getting this area repaved it will make a huge difference for our Fair and our rentals. The area to cover is 90,000+/-. Director Perea asked if there is an alternative to asphalt for the hot summer months. King explained that we have tried pervious concrete and concrete, but that asphalt is the most effective product to use. The maintenance department has made improvements to the sewer, power, and water in anticipation of this project.

Chief Executive Officer King reported on Sponsorships, Entertainment, New Projects, and Improvements.

- CEO King reported that she had a vision statement and update for 2023 but in the interest of time if the Board would like to postpone that until the March meeting. The Board agreed to postpone until March.
- CEO King handed out the 2023 theme packet for our buildings to decorate around. The Fair tag line is always Big Times are Back, but our internal theme is Picture Yourself Here! Focusing on the FUN and experience you get to have at the Fair. We will have elements of this in each building. We are meeting with a photo mosaic company that will take your photo and create a photo wall. The plan is to have this in the fine arts and photography building.

- CEO King reported that she is meeting with the San Joaquin Valley area CEOs to work on policy development. A lot of Fairs are having issues developing policies and it is better to work together: We will be meeting on March 7th.
- CEO King reported that we have had a lot of emails going around with our entertainment buyers, Roadshow. We have offers out on The Offspring, Expose and En Vogue, working on a good act for Senior's Day and looking at Nav and Kenny Loggins. We are also booking big thrill acts for our small stages.
- CEO King asked the Board if there was anything that they would like to see on the Friday Memos. There weren't any recommendations, but the Board expressed their appreciation.

ITEM #17. BOARD RECOMMENDATION FOR FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:

Director Flores asked if there was an update on the AC projects and CEO King said she would get that information to Director Flores.

President Gonsalves requested to add the formation of committees.

Director Flores expressed that he may not be in person at the next meeting due to his knee replacement surgery that is scheduled for March, but stated he would be able to zoom.
