I, along with representatives from six of Maine fairs attended a briefing on the H-2B visa update hosted by Seasonal Employment Alliance at the Harraseeket Inn in Freeport. The update was very informative. Also in attendance were Rockwell Amusements and Gillett Shows. After the zoom meeting, all present attended a luncheon with Senator Susan Collins, a longtime advocate for Maine Fairs and the H-2B program. The Senator is working tirelessly in attempting to arrange for more visas to be released. She did inform the group that an additional 65,000 visas will be released in 2023. I'd like to thank those of you that were able to attend, and for you that may see the Senator in the coming days, please thank her for her work on this important issue.

I'd like to thank our MAAF conference committee for all of the work they have done on getting your 2023 conference program together. Darcy Winslow has more on this in the newsletter.

I am looking forward to connecting with the Maine delegation of about 12 fair representatives at the National IAFE Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana later in the month.
