The proximity to world-class all season mountain sport recreation, coupled with unparalleled beauty and a vibrant downtown creates a setting that is not only unique, but inspiring to all that live and visit here.

The Goal Foundation was founded in 2001 with the mission to inspire the Greater Ogden Community and its visitors to **"Get Out And Live!"** by participating, volunteering and spectating at recreational events, programs and activities. The GOAL Foundation is about "giving back", which is evident in the level of commitment and dedication of our Board of Directors, Events Team, Volunteers, Staff, Sponsors, and Community Partners.

2019 was an incredibly impactful year for the GOAL Foundation. At the heart of the organization are our amazing 4,187 GOAL Volunteers that contributed 36,085 hours to GOAL produced and supported events in the community. 2019 also saw 8,865 athletes from 47 States and 5 Counties **"Get Out And Live"** and participate in GOAL produced events. Youth programming continues to be a major focus and expand, and in 2019, 425 children ages 6-14, participated in 16 weeks of summer camps ranging from mountain biking to backpacking and rock climbing. As a result of fundraising and our generous donors, GOAL continued to give back by awarding 19 children financial scholarships so they could **"Get Out And Live"** at GOAL Summer Camps. The GOAL Shoe Giveback Program and Young Runners Program continues to grow with eleven participating schools in which children receive running shoes and participate throughout the year to earn entries into the Ogden Marathon Kids K or 5K.

The GOAL Foundation's impact and reach is far broader than just events. The GOAL Foundation truly makes a difference, and has a positive impact in the lives of our athletes, our volunteers, our spectators, our youth, and our community. There is no greater gift than the act of "giving back", and we are sincerely grateful for the opportunity to build our community, build families, build partnerships, and ultimately inspire everyone to **"Get Out And Live"!**


