1. Tiny Mister and Tiny Miss contestants must be ages 3 – 5 as of the date of the contest. Lil' Mister and Lil' Miss contestants must be ages 6 years – 2nd grade as of the date of the contest.
2. An Indemnity Form must be submitted with the entry form. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of the contestant.
3. A link to a questionnaire will be sent to the parent. A recent and appropriate photograph of the contestant and questionnaire must be completed no later than **Monday, March 24, 2025. The questionnaire information and photograph will be published in the program for this show. The committee reserves the right to edit your information to accommodate the space in the program.**
4. Tiny and Lil' contestants may ride in the Parade which will be held on Saturday, March 29, 2025. Contestants will assemble at 9:00 a.m. at the VFW Post 5400 Parking Lot, Hwy 6 in Santa Fe and the parade will start at 10:00 a.m. All contestants will ride on one float. Western Wear will be the attire for the parade. The theme of the parade will be announced at the parents meeting. We will need volunteers to pull the float and decorate.
5. The contestant's parent(s) or guardian(s) agree with the Galveston County Fair & Rodeo, Inc. that the contest is for the purpose of extending an opportunity for the contestants to participate in a good experience and fun event. Each contestant and parents are expected to act properly and to present a good image.
6. The interviews will be held on March 30, 2025 at 2pm. Tiny and Lil' contestants will be judged at the interview on personality, attire and poise. The contest judging will be held on April 5, 2025. Contestants will be judged on the day of the contest on talent.
7. At the interview, Tiny and Lil' contestants will be asked a series of simple questions in front of the judges. During the contest, they will be introduced on stage and then have the opportunity to perform a simple talent (maximum time limit of two minutes) such as singing, telling jokes, skipping rope, or whatever talent they have that they do best. Please know what your talent will be by March 30, 2025.
8. The contestants' parent(s) or guardian(s) agree the time, manner, and method of judging shall be within the discretion of the Galveston County Fair & Rodeo, Inc. and the decision of the judges in final.
9. Only the contestants are allowed free admission the day of the Contest.
10. One boy will be named Tiny Mister Cowboy and one girl will be named Tiny Miss Cowgirl. One boy will be named Lil' Mister Cowboy and one girl will be named Lil' Miss Cowgirl. There will also be awards for 1st and 2nd runner up in each category and Most Talented.
11. **A mandatory parent meeting will be held Friday, March 14, 2025, at 6:30 p.m.** in the Youth Building located at the Galveston County Fairgrounds. A parent or a representative must attend the meeting to sign up for interview times.
