Horse Park to accommodate the growth in size and attendance. Over the years, Yoshino Cherry Trees have been planted all around Conyers and can be enjoyed on the grounds of the former Maxell complex, Conyers City Hall, Conyers-Rockdale Chamber of Commerce, Olde Towne Conyers, schools and while driving along the entrance to the Georgia International Horse Park.

Ever since that simple beginning, the Conyers Cherry Blossom Festival has concentrated on bringing the community together while focusing on cultural understanding and friendship through art, music, dance, crafts, food and entertainment. The festival prides itself on offering a quality event and

experience to the community, and corporate contributions help to maintain the quality and diversity of the arts while keeping the price low to the public. Festival goers enjoy a free admission into the event with a \$8 parking fee.
