The Georgia International Horse Park has been groomed for greatness from the beginning. Since opening its gates in September of 1995, the GIHP has already served as the equestrian venue for the largest sporting event in the world: The 1996 Centennial Olympic Games. The park was the setting for all equestrian events, first ever mountain biking event, as well as the final two events of the modern pentathlon.

Today, the tradition continues as the GIHP plays host to a remarkable variety of special events: equestrian competitions, festivals, concerts, wedding receptions, family reunions and sports competitions, as well as corporate events. The park's sprawling 1,400 acres can accommodate events of all shapes and sizes. An estimated 500,000 people visit the Horse Park annually.

The Georgia International Horse Park hosts the Conyers Cherry Blossom Festival each Spring, now in its 40th year. This is an award-winning festival, attracting an average of 20,000 in attendance annually.

The Conyers Cherry Blossom Festival originated as a way to encourage cultural understanding and friendship through international music, dance, games, food and crafts. The festival offers multiple stages for continuous entertainment, over 300 booths consisting of art and craft vendors, various children's activities and civic and nonprofit organizations.
