## Restoration Storehouse Center

The Restoration Storehouse Center is one of the best locations to enjoy the blooming of the cherry trees in Conyers, Georgia. The trees you see here were donated by Hideo Ongino, former President of Maxell Corporation of America. This was the original location of the Conyers Cherry Blossom Festival when it began in 1982, when the Maxell Corporation, along with the Chamber of Commerce, held the first festival to share the Japanese culture with the Conyers Community. The Festival remained at this location until 1997, when it moved to the Georgia International Horse Park to accommodate its growth.

## Olde Town Conyers

Cherry trees line the railroad tracks in Olde Town Conyers near the Conyers Welcome Center. While you are there, stop by the Welcome Center located in the Historic Train Depot to learn how the railroad played into the rich history of Conyers and its inception. Olde Town Conyers also features many specialty stores and restaurants, and don't be surprised to find a celebration, parade or festival going on in Olde Town. The area is full of diverse and fun activities.
