BUDDING ARTISTS PROGRAM

FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12

The Georgia National Fair Youth Art Exhibition uses guidelines established by Georgia art educators with regard to proper age limits for competition. They recommend that children under age 12 should not have their work juried. Our rules comply with their recommendations and we have adopted their philosophy to govern competitions throughout the Georgia Living Program. Exceptions to this rule apply only to "live" contests on site where parents are nearby to lend support, such as the Soap Carving Contest.

"Budding Artists" is an opportunity for children below age 12 to become exhibitors in the Fine Arts and Home Arts Programs. **Their work will not be judged.** *No prize money will be offered.* However, each exhibitor will receive a Georgia National Fair "Budding Artist" ribbon and their work will be displayed.

1. All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the Georgia National Fair General Rules And Regulations. PLEASE NOTE...IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITYTO READ AND UNDERSTAND THE RULES. - 2. All exhibitors must register by completing and mailing an official General entry form or entering online.
- 3. Work must have been completed by the Budding Artist within the past year.
- 4. Each Budding Artist may submit a maximum of two (2) items from the list below.
- 5. Drawings, photography, and paintings must be mounted on fomecore or mountboard (<u>not construction paper or posterboard</u>) to stabilize them for hanging. Do not attach wire or strings for hanging. Do not frame. Size limit for all two-dimensional entries is 16" x 24".
- 6. Three-dimensional pieces must not be too fragile to display. All clay must be fired.
- 7. Attention teachers and group leaders: Please do not submit more than two works from the same class project if the project produces look-alike pieces.
