**EXHIBITORS ARE CAUTIONED TO CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING RULES & REGULATIONS,** AS THEY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE, SPLIT, OR CANCEL CLASSES AT THEIR DISCRETION. ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS NOT COVERED IN THESE GENERAL RULES WILL BE DECIDED UPON BY SHOW MANAGEMENT: THEIR DECISION WILL BE FINAL. SHOW OFFICE HOURS WILL BE POSTED & ANNOUNCED.

# **ENTRY DEADLINE & REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Horses will be received Thursday, October 5<sup>th</sup> and released on Sunday, October 8th, following the show. There will be **NO EARLY ARRIVALS ALLOWED, NO EXCEPTIONS**, per Georgia National Fair administration.
- 2. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**: Each horse MUST have proof of a NEGATIVE COGGINS test within 12 months of show date. Horses entering Georgia must have an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that meets State of Georgia requirements. Contact the GA Department of Agriculture at (404) 656-3600 or (800) 282-5852.
- 3. PRE-ENTRIES must be <u>postmarked</u> by <u>September 1</u>st and include: (a) Separate ENTRY FORM for each horse (hitches use single form); (b) WAIVER(s) of Liability signed by owner & EACH exhibitor; and (c) Valid PAYMENT to cover show fees.
- **4. SOCIAL SECURITY # & SIGNATURE** of owner **REQUIRED** for premium checks.
- **5. PAYMENT** for all show fees will be accepted in the form of a CHECK made payable to: Georgia Draft Horse Association (GDHA) or by CREDIT/DEBIT CARD using our online payment link, PAYPAL.ME/GDHA. \*NOTE —Online payments must add a 4% transaction fee; there is a \$35 NSF fee for any returned checks).
- **6. EARLY BIRD RAFFLE:** Register BEFORE the pre-entry deadline and your name will be entered for chance to WIN a \$250 Visa Gift Card! (Complete entry & fees must be received by 9/1/23 to qualify). Drawing will be held at Exhibitor's Party!
- **7. CANCELLATIONS OR CHANGES** must be made no later than SEPT. 15, 2023.
- **8. CLASS ADDS** only be accepted up until Friday at 2:00pm, then scratches only.
- **9. REFUNDS** will NOT be given; NO REFUNDS for classes scratched or missed.
- 10. EXHIBITOR PACKETS with stall assignments and parking pass/gate entry information will be emailed to exhibitors at least (7) days before the show date.

# **SHOW DIVISIONS**

### (HD-S) = HEAVY DRAFT SHOW HITCH

- Open to purebred Belgians, Clydesdales, Percherons, Shires ONLY.
- Eligible for classes marked (HD) and (HD-S), and proper age/sex halter classes.
- SHOW HARNESSES (Scotch Collars) REQUIRED.
- Horses may NOT cross-enter into Heavy Draft Pleasure (HD-P) classes.

#### (HD-P) = HEAVY DRAFT PLEASURE

- Open to purebred Belgians, Clydesdales, Percherons, & Shires ONLY.
  Eligible for classes marked (HD) and (HD-P) and proper age/sex halter classes.
- Pleasure/Work Harness (NO Show Harnesses or Scotch Collars permitted)
- Horses may NOT cross-enter into Heavy Draft Show Hitch (HD-S) classes.

#### (LD) = LIGHT DRAFT

- Open to all other Draft horse breeds and crosses (must show Draft characteristics) such as: American Creams, Brabants, Drums, Fjords, Friesians, Gypsy Vanners, Haflingers, Spotted Drafts\*, Suffolks, & Sugarbush Drafts.
- Horses may NOT cross-enter into Heavy Draft (HD-S) or Pleasure (HD-P).

# **GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:**

- **11. HORSE'S AGE** based on a calendar year, starting January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year foaled.
- **12. SHOW CONDITION:** Animals must be in show condition to receive premiums.
- 13. BACK NUMBERS will be assigned to each entry. This number will identify horses in the show and must be displayed properly when entries are being judged. Any entry that does not wear the correct back number for the class they are entered in will NOT receive any premiums earned in that class.
- 14. PROPER SHOW ATTIRE is required to be worn by exhibitors (including headers/helpers) while in the show ring. Dress appropriately; exhibitors & headers should look neat and clean. (NO blue jeans, shorts, flip-flops, or Crocs® permitted).
- 15. NO CAMPING IS ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE BARNS. Only one individual may stay the night inside barns to tend to animals and must do so within assigned stalls.
- **16. BARN AISLES** must remain clear of clutter for both safety and appearance.
- **17. NO COOKING** is allowed inside the barns to comply with local fire codes.
- 18. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PERDUE ARENA, STAGING AREAS OR IN OR AROUND PRACTICE ARENA. Due to the NO PET POLICY on the Fairgrounds, dogs of horse show exhibitors are restricted to stabling area of horse complex, must be kept on a leash, and may NOT be tied in barn aisle. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs. This rule is strictly enforced with a \$200 fine imposed to anyone in violation.
- 19. NO UNAUTHORIZED ATVs, Golf Carts, Motorcycles or Bicycles allowed on grounds. Skateboards, Scooters, Roller Skates/Blades, Hover Boards, and other similar mechanical equipment is strictly prohibited on GA National Fairgrounds.
- **20. NONCOMPLIANCE**: Exhibitors not cooperating with security personnel or officials of the Show in all matters of policy, including parking, will have their entries canceled and will be ordered to leave the grounds immediately.

# STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

**21.** The Georgia National Fair & AgriCenter, and the GA Draft Horse Association, Inc. specifically, jointly or severally, assume no liability or responsibility whatsoever for any damages or injuries to animal or person and/or loss of equipment. Exhibitors are responsible for their animals; unruly animals may be dismissed.

WARNING: UNDER GEORGIA LAW, AN EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISK OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES. PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 4 OF OFFICIAL GEORGIA ANNOTATED.

# **PARKING AND PASSES**

- **22. ADMISSION BRACELETS:** Complimentary bracelet passes for the Draft Horse Show will be included in each exhibitor's entry packet, which will be available for pickup at Show Office upon arrival. If an admission bracelet has to be cut off or is lost for any reason, it is exhibitor's responsibility to purchase replacement from the GA National Fair Livestock Credentials Office (quantities are very limited).
- **23. NO VEHICLE OR TRAILER PARKING INSIDE THE GATES.** All vehicles with passes will be parked in designated areas outside of the Fair Horse Show Entrance. Vehicle parking passes are valid for parking in designated areas ONLY, not for entrance of driver or passengers. Parking is limited; vehicle pass does not guarantee space. EACH VEHICLE and EACH PERSON must have a bracelet/pass to enter the gate!
- **24.** All vehicles with trailers hauling horses will be allowed to enter the East Gate.
- **25.** If you made reservations for an RV Hookup or are camping on the fairgrounds, you will receive an RV Camping parking pass when checking in at the GATE.
- **26. RV HOOKUP & CAMPING RESERVATIONS** must be made with, and fees paid directly to, the Georgia National Fair by calling 800-987-3247 or reserve your space online at <a href="https://www.qnfa.com/p/reservations">www.qnfa.com/p/reservations</a> (available starting August 1st).
- **27. HORSE TRAILERS** may be dropped in designated areas without a vehicle pass. Any vehicle other than trailers MUST have a pass to enter/park in designated areas.
- 28. All vehicles must be out of the barn area by 8:00am each morning.
- **29. NO PARKING** is permitted on the <u>asphalt next to the barns</u> or in front of the <u>entrance to the staging area for Perdue Arena.</u>

# **STABLING & CARE OF ANIMALS**

- **30.** Draft horses will be stabled in **BARN #2**, adjacent to Perdue Arena. The barn features 480 stalls (10' x 10') with easy access to water, two (2) indoor wash racks, restrooms with showers and hot water, two (2) covered farrier stations, large ceiling fans for improved air circulation, and is adjacent to the RV parking lot.
- **31. STALLS** are permanent 10'x10' box stalls with concrete floors & sliding doors.
- **32. PINE SHAVINGS:** Two (2) bags of pine shavings will be provided for each paid stall. Additional shavings must be ordered directly from GA National Fairgrounds and are available for \$7.00 per bag. Order online at <a href="https://www.showshavings.com">www.showshavings.com</a>
- **33. MISTREATMENT**: Show Management reserves the right to remove any exhibitor/owner/trainer from grounds who is deemed to be mistreating an animal.
- **34.** All owners and those in charge of property or horses shall care for, guard, protect and preserve the same. The Georgia National Fair and/or the Georgia Draft Horse Association will not be responsible for any loss or damage.

#### **SCHEDULE**

- **35. BE ON TIME** for each class you have entered. Please check in with the Paddock Master and advise of any possible conflicts. Due to the number of classes and time, 5-minute GATE CALL may be put into effect at any time upon announcement, meaning AFTER 5 MINUTES or a THIRD CALL BY THE ANNOUNCER, the show ring gate will be closed and NO EXHIBITORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE RING.
- **36. ADDS/SCRATCHES**: All class changes MUST be made in person in the Show Office. \*NEW THIS YEAR <u>NO CLASS ADDITIONS</u> will be accepted AFTER 2:00PM on <u>FRIDAY</u>, <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>. Only SCRATCHES will be accepted for the duration of the show. Refunds will NOT be given; this includes NO REFUNDS for any classes scratched or missed.
- **37. CLASS CANCELLATIONS:** If we find that we are ahead of/behind schedule, show staff will make every effort to keep exhibitors in the barn area informed of class status. We will give as much notice as possible and ask that exhibitors do the same and notify the Show Office as soon as possible if you choose to scratch a class.
- **38. EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITY**: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be present and ready to enter the arena for each properly entered and paid class. Classes missed due to lack of attention or preparedness, inadequate entry process or for any other reason cannot be re-run, refunded or substituted. Exhibitors should not rely strictly on gate/class calls or possible announcements on the PA system, and a nonfunctioning PA system cannot be blamed for missed classes. Exhibitors entering the show ring and participating in a class in which said horse is NOT duly and properly entered may result in disqualification and may be subject to penalty and censure by the GA National Fair Draft Horse Show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/trainer/owner to be aware of each and all classes your horse is properly entered in. DO NOT enter the arena unless you are sure your horse is/was duly entered in that class with the Show Office. Class entries CANNOT be processed and WILL NOT be accepted at the gate.

# **YOUTH EXHIBITORS**

- 39. RULES GOVERNING EXHIBITORS 18 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER:
  - (a) Age of Youth is determined based on their age as of **January 1, 2023**.
  - **(b)** Youth drivers must be accompanied by a capable adult in all cart classes;
  - (c) Youth may NOT show a stallion in ANY class;
  - (d) Youth may ONLY enter classes marked YOUTH or appropriate OPEN classes.
  - (e) Youth exhibitors are encouraged to participate in the Pia Johansson/Kim Smith Memorial Youth Challenge! (See #49 SPECIAL AWARDS for details)

# **SPORTSMANSHIP**

**40.** Any unsportsmanlike conduct or discourtesy toward a judge, show official, show staff, or Fairground personnel by an exhibitor or owner, will disqualify both the exhibitor and horse from the show; all fees and premiums forfeited.

# **JUDGES AND JUDGING PROCEDURE**

- **41. POLICIES FOR SELECTING JUDGES** and of determining judging systems rest solely with Show Management. Judges will be familiar with all rules, regulations, and procedures of the Georgia National Fair & the Georgia Draft Horse Association.
- **42. JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL** in all cases and no appeal will be considered except in cases of written protest. If misrepresentation, fraud, error or collusion is discovered after awards have been given, Show Mgt. may decide on final placings.
- **43. INTERFERENCE WITH JUDGE**: If any exhibitor or his/her representative interferes with the judge in any way, or shows disrespect to them, show officials, or staff, Show Mgt. may exclude exhibitor from further competition, withhold any premiums that may have been awarded, or take any other steps deemed desirable.
- **44. FORFEITURE OF PREMIUM MONEY**: Any entry excused for any reason during a class will forfeit placing and premiums.
- **45. PROTESTS** must be filed in Show Office within one (1) hour of occurrence. A \$250 fee (refundable only if protest is decided in your favor). Decisions will be determined by Show Management and their decision shall be final.

# **PREMIUMS & AWARDS**

- **46. PREMIUM CHECKS** will be mailed by the Georgia National Fair as soon as possible after the show and are valid for up to 90 days from the issue date. Checks not cashed within 90 days will NOT be reissued.
- **47. PAYBACK SCHEDULES** for SIX-HORSE HITCH (Open All-Breed \$3,000 payout and \$5,000 payout split equally) Classic Cart Series (\$1,000 payout) is listed below:

**48. STALL DECORATING CONTEST**: 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place trophies & ribbons will be awarded for Best Decorated Stall, sponsored by Berry Oaks Farm. Judging will take place on Saturday morning with the presentation of awards on Saturday afternoon

**49. SPECIAL AWARDS** will be presented in honor and memory:

The **Ken Janes Memorial Trophy** awarded to the winner of Men's Show Cart.

The **Renon Pruiett Memorial Trophy** given to the 4-Horse Hitch class winner.

The Karen McQueen Memorial Trophy given to winner of HD Pleasure Driving.

The **Rebecca Cannon Under Saddle Achievement Award** given to the winner in each HD-S (Adult) Walk/Trot Under Saddle classes (English & Western).

The **Pia Johansson & Kim Smith Memorial Youth Challenge** is a highpoint competition for exhibitors age 18 & under, with separate divisions for Heavy Draft and Light Draft. The Challenge was created in loving memory of two very special GDHA members who made considerable efforts to share their passion and knowledge with our draft horse youth.

- (a) Youth exhibitors may compete with any horse and may participate in both HD and LD classes throughout the show BUT may only EARN POINTS in ONE division (Heavy Draft OR Light Draft).
- **(b)** Exhibitors may compete in any of the qualifying classes, but MUST declare which division they are competing for points in.
- (c) Qualifying classes for the HEAVY DŘAFT Division: (HD) Youth Showmanship (either age group), (HD) Youth English Under Saddle W/T, (HD) Youth Western Under Saddle W/T, (HD-S) Youth Classic Cart, and (HD-P) Youth Pleasure Driving.
- (d) Qualifying classes for the LIGHT DRAFT Division: (LD) Youth Showmanship, (LD) Youth English Under Saddle W/T, (LD) Youth Western Under Saddle W/T, and (LD) Youth Pleasure Driving.
- (e) POINTS for each placing will be counted as follows: 1st place (10 pts), 2nd place (9 pts), 3rd place (8 pts), 4th place (7 pts), 5th place (6 pts), 6th place (5 pts), 7th place (4 pts), 8th place (3 pts), 9th place (2 pts), and 10th place (1 pt). All remaining exhibitors will earn 1 point.
- (f) In the event of a tie, the youth with greatest number of 1st places will win.
  If still tied, the youth with most 2nd places will win and so on.
  (g) Total points for each exhibitor will be tallied after all Youth classes
- (g) Total points for each exhibitor will be tallied after all Youth classes finalized. Awards will be presented during Sunday show; all youth exhibitors must be present to receive their award and medal.

# **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & RULES**

BE SAFE! Check that all riding tack, harness and equipment is clean and in good repair. Headers are required during hitching. All classes shall be judged on turnout and appearance as appropriate to the class, riding/driving ability, willingness and response of the animal(s), and teamwork between horse(s) and rider/driver. Any entry may be excused from show ring or fairgrounds if the Judge deems them hazardous to other participants. Classes may be split into heats (at the judge's discretion) based on number of entries, or if more than 9 entries in a cart class.

**OBSTACLE CLASSES**: Course diagrams will be posted prior to the start of the show;

- (a) Judged on performance and accurate completion within allotted time limit;
- (b) Exhibitors should look neat and clean; jeans are acceptable for "fun" classes.
- (c) Exhibitor will be asked to move on to next obstacle after two (2) refusals;
- **(d)** In the event of a tie, the faster time will win;
- (e) IN-HAND is intended for young/green horses ONLY. Entries in this class are NOT eligible to compete in Obstacle Under Saddle or Obstacle Cart;
- (f) The same HORSE may not show more than ONCE in Barrel Racing.
- **(g)** The same HORSE may not show more than ONCE in any one Obstacle class.

**HEAVY DRAFT HALTER CLASSES** will follow the standard course for a halter class and will be judged on the presentation and confirmation of horse. Shoeing of halter horses is optional. Whip person permitted but not required. Mane/tail decoration appropriate to the breed is encouraged. Exhibitors may have multiple entries per class. Classes may be combined at the discretion of Show Committee. All mares and stallions MUST be registered with their respective breed association; registration number is REOUIRED to be on entry form.

- **BROODMARE**: Mare has birthed a foal in the given calendar year (after 12/31/22)
- **YELD MARE**: Mare did not produce a foal in the given calendar year (after 12/31/22)
- **GET OF SIRE**: Two (2) or more horses from the same sire.
- **PRODUCE OF DAM**: Two (2) or more horses from the same dam.
- GEORGIA OWNED & BRED: Entrant must be a Georgia resident, currently owns (or previously owned) the dam at time of breeding, and currently owns offspring.
- CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Limited to FIRST & SECOND place animals only.

\*CLASSIC CART: Membership to the North American Classic Cart Series (\$50/year) is REQUIRED to enter; or a Classic Series Show Pass may be obtained for \$25 fee (paid directly to Show) which allows entry to ONE show per year for the Classic Cart Series

\*GDHA MEMBERS' SHOW CART & PLEASURE DRIVING: Entries must be owned and driven by a current member of the Georgia Draft Horse Association (GDHA).

**PLEASURE DRIVING:** Horses must be harnessed to an appropriate 2-wheel vehicle, Scotch Collars <u>NOT</u> PERMITTED; class NOT judged by Carriage Association rules.

**SHOWMANSHIP:** Classes to be judged on handler's ability; horse is not to count.

**UNDER SADDLE CLASSES**: Horses & riders should be dressed & tacked appropriately to the discipline in which they are showing. Horses may not be shown in blinder bridles. Participants should enter ring at a trot. Horse will be shown both directions of the ring with gaits at the discretion of the judge. Passing slower horses is permitted. Horses will lineup, should stand quietly and will be asked to back.

\*YOUTH CLASSIC CART: There is NO FEE to participate in the Youth Cart Series, but you must REGISTER ONLINE at <a href="https://www.drivesix.com">www.drivesix.com</a> each year for points to be tracked.

**YOUTH DECORATING CLASS:** Youth exhibitors must provide their own horse, assistant, equipment, and decorations. Exhibitors must roll a mane, tail and foretop in 30 minutes. Class will be judged on neatness/tightness of mane, tail and foretop and overall appearance of the horse.

**YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP & DRIVING** classes shall be judged on youth exhibitor's showmanship ability, the horse is not to count. Judge is encouraged to share helpful advice and positive comments to exhibitors after class has been judged.

\*SHOW HITCH SPOTTED DRAFTS are permitted to enter the following HD non-breed specific classes: 6-Up, 4-Up, Unicorn, Men's/Ladies/Youth Team, Men's/Ladies/Youth Cart, Classic Cart, Obstacle Cart, In-Hand Obstacle, Youth Obstacle, Youth Decorating, & Youth Showmanship. At this time, they are NOT eligible to compete in breed-specific classes and may ONLY enter classes listed above.
