CURFEWS – NOISE LEVELS – MONETARY PENALTIES

1. No racing or other events shall occur after 10:00 pm.
2. No race cars or other vehicles are permitted on the racetrack prior to 3:00 pm on any scheduled race event.
3. No vehicles are permitted on the racetrack other than race days or scheduled approved events.
4. All race cars shall be removed from the racetrack and pit area by 10:45 pm on all race days and no race cars will be allowed on the Fairgrounds other than scheduled race days.
5. All racetrack lights shall be extinguished by 11:00 pm.
6. All other facility lights shall be extinguished by 11:30 pm including parking lot lights.
7. Noise levels, as defined and established by the State of California, at any race meet or scheduled practice meet shall not exceed 95 decibels. Contractor is required to maintain and submit a sound log that is to be reviewed by the Association weekly. The Association can request the log immediately following a race should it be necessary. Failure to provide the log will result in a \$50.00 per day penalty.

MONETARY PENALTIES

1. For lights left on the racetrack after the 11:00 pm curfew a monetary penalty shall be assessed at \$50.00 per hour for the first hour or portion thereof and \$50.00 per hour for every hour or portion thereof after the first hour.
2. Penalties for violations of curfews and for exceeding established decibels noise level limits are due in the Association Office one (1) working day after each violation has been assessed.

Violations are as follows: The Contractor shall be assessed a monetary penalty for any violations of the City Sound Ordinance. The sound curfew time is 10:00 PM. First penalty will result in a \$200.00 fine, second penalty will result in a \$500.00 fine, third penalty will result in suspension of the next contracted race date. Contractor will also meet with the CEO and Board of Directors Racing committee to discuss further actions.

3. Failure to remit said penalties will result in suspension of racing until penalties have been paid.
