### INFORMATION:

After many months of planning and hard work, the 2024 Glenn County Fair Junior Livestock Show and Auction is upon us.

This show and sale are a culmination of our local youth exhibitors livestock projects. With many hours spent raising, conditioning, and preparing their livestock projects to meet the livestock industry standards. The animals presented on May 18th will have been judged, and graded as market ready.

There are many ways to support these youth livestock projects. One is to register as a buyer for the Glenn County Junior Livestock Auction. You may do so the day of the sale, prior to the sale, or online at <https://glenn.fairwire.com/buyerlogon.aspx>.

If you are unable to attend the auction in person you may also register at EZ2Bid.com. Where you will be able to view and live bid along with the auction. You must pre-register on EZ2Bid.com to be able to bid.

Another great option to support local youth, would be a buyers group, stockman's award, or price support. If you would like more information regarding any of these options please contact NorCal Youth Livestock Association.

Should you choose to support a current year exhibitor, with a livestock or Vo-Ed project that is sold through the Glenn County Fair Junior Livestock Auction you can do so in the Livestock Office on the day of the auction. Add-ons can be the amount of your choosing and must be paid immediately. Add-ons can be done up to one hour following the conclusion of the auction

## **BUYER:**

You bid a price per pound on the animal of your choice against other bidders. Except for chicken, turkeys and rabbits which are sold as a lot. The bid amount accepted is the amount the bidder agrees to pay Glenn County Fair Junior Livestock Auction. Harvest fees will be collected at time of purchase. If you are purchasing for another individual or business, you must be an authorized agent for that individual or business. Should you need assistance with this please contact the fair office, 530-865-1168.

## **MULTIPLE BUYERS PER ANIMAL:**

When two or more buyers decide to buy an animal together. The final bid amount accepted by the auctioneer is then split between the multiple buyers as decided amongst themselves. Each buyer is then responsible for the percentage of purchase agreed upon by their name, as listed on the sale agreement.

## **DISPOSITION OF ANIMALS:**

There are three options available for disposition of animals; custom, live and resale. Once the sale agreement has been signed, disposition of animal may not be changed. This is in accordance to California State Fair Rules. The sale of champions is a terminal sale.

## **CUSTOM PROCESSING:**

All animals selected as resale or custom will be processed at a USDA certified facility. Custom purchases are then delivered to the one of the five pre-selected butcher shops awaiting buyer's cut and wrap instructions. The buyer is be responsible for all processing charges.

## **LIVE PICKUP:**

If buyer selects live pick up on the sale agreement, this animal can only be picked up after 4:00PM on Sunday, May 19, 2024 A signed release form must be presented to exit the fairgrounds. This form is given out at the livestock office to the authorized buyer.

## **RESALE:**

The buyer consigns the animal back to the Glenn County Fair for resale and only pays the difference between the bid amount and the current set resale

## **2. New Sale Order**

**Morning Kick-Off:** Starting at **9:00 AM**, we'll start the auction with 50% of our total number of swine, goats and sheep. Followed by Beef and Beef Replacement Heifers.

**Champions take the Stage:** The coveted Sale of Champion is scheduled for 2:00PM, or as close to that time as possible.

**Wrapping up the Sale:** Post-Sale of Champion, we will continue the auction with of rabbits, poultry and turkeys, leading into the sale of the remaining 50% of swine, goats and sheep.
