

Who Are We?

When the Department of Fairs and Expositions cut funding to local fairs in 2011, the need to form a non-profit that would support activities that occur at the fair was recognized. In response to that, a group of Glenn County 4-H leaders, FFA advisors and community members formed a corporation and have subsequently completed all the paperwork and received declaration of meeting the criteria of a nonprofit 501(c)3 organization in support of youth in agricultural education. We support agricultural education projects including the University of California's 4-H Youth Development Program, the school-based Future Farmers of America, Grange and independent exhibitors.

The Clover and Glenn County Buyers' Groups successfully developed and managed by Phil McCorkle and Irene Skala were formalized under the umbrella of this corporation. As word of this charitable work spread, early in 2014 we filed a dba as NorCal Youth Livestock Association allowing us the opportunity to continue to grow and assist more youth across Northern California. The Mount Lassen Buyers' Group managed by Michell Williams was added in May 2018. In 2020, we filed a dba as Glenn Ag Expo and sponsor that event.

We are happy to report 95% of your donations go directly to the youth in support of their projects. The remainder is used to offset the operational costs such as annual filing fees, tax preparation, check stock, etc. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact us.

The animals and projects that are presented for sale to the community represent many hours of hard work and a considerable amount of money invested by 4-H and FFA members. Many of our youth support breeding projects in addition to their market project and also show at other junior shows such as Junior Grand National and specialty breed shows. Exhibitors have attended many training meetings, learning activities and meet strict requirements to participate in these activities. Our association wants to make sure that these young people are supported in their endeavors. This is accomplished in several different ways.

Buyer Groups

Buyer groups offer the opportunity to contribute a flat amount prior to the event. These donations are pooled and stretched to assist as many exhibitors as possible. These groups may purchase "no bid" animals, helping to maintain a floor price throughout the auction. Any proceeds remaining after a sale event may be used for price supports. Contributors to these groups do not receive any livestock, meat or other products in exchange for their donation. We can provide the structure to house your buyer group.

Stockman Awards

Know a young person that did a great job and you want to encourage them to continue their agricultural education? Here is your opportunity to acknowledge the exhibitor for a job well done. Nominate them for an individual award (will not exceed \$500 or \$1/lb. for beef exhibitors per nomination). Awards are made if youth meet criteria and if funding is available. These awards are issued in a separate check after the event.

Price Supports

We can support your fair's exhibitors through price supports.

Donations may be made to support a designated specie, FFA chapter or 4-H club. Please make your check payable to NorCal Youth Livestock Association, note which group you would like to support and the fair where they exhibit in the memo line of the check.

Price supports level the field, equalizing prices received to help insure that each youngster receives a fair price helping to cover their costs. A panel of four or more directors review the sale results, evaluate the available funds and make the assignments of price supports to youth exhibitors. These are an "add on" and exhibitors are issued a separate check after the sale.

Any awards or supports not claimed by December 1 of exhibit year may be used for general program support in subsequent years.
