



Event Name: Glenn County Fair Dairy Show 2025

Dates of Event: April 25th, 2025 (CEO mentioned 2-day show), regular fair scheduled for May 15 to 18, 2025 recommend two-week separation between events at minimum.

Location of Event: Glenn County Fairgrounds, Orland, CA

Summary of Proposed Event: The following is proposed to continue with the Glenn County Fair Dairy exhibition 2025 by limiting the high-risk groups of cattle and considering public health regarding H5N1. Entries will be limited to the region that has not been exposed to H5N1.

Traceability: All show cattle must have an 840 RFID tag placed in their ear, and the NPIN for the farm of origin will be required for each animal/group.

Classes of Dairy Cattle allowed in the show:

- Non-lactating dairy cattle
- Heifers not older than 20 months of age
- Heifers not greater than 200 DCC
- No out-of-state cattle
- Limited to cattle from the North Coast/North State Region (Counties North of I-80)
- A testing protocol may be developed by the fair committee to provide assurance that only negative animals are being received.

Biosecurity Requirements For Exhibitors/Visitors:

- Take rectal temperature of cattle on arrival and refuse entry to animals with a temperature >103°F, animals being exhibited must be free from clinical signs of H5N1 Bird Flu (no nasal discharge, lethargy, off feed, etc.).
- Place foot baths with a disinfectant labeled for “Avian Influenza A Virus” at entrances to the barn. Foot bath disinfectant will be changed as often as needed to maintain efficacy and not less than once every 12 hours.
- Hand washing/hand sanitizing stations will be placed around the facility.
- Exhibitors will provide their own individual feed and water buckets that will not be shared between participants (unless from the same household/farm).

Biosecurity Requirements For the Facility Following the Show:

- All bedding will be removed and disposed of in a location that has no contact with poultry, dairy animals, and has no potential for runoff to animal facilities.
- Pens, livestock equipment, feed and water troughs will be cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant labeled for “Avian Influenza A Virus”.

All exhibitors assume their own risk for the potential for disease transmission while participating in the show. If the disease status in the region changes prior to the show this proposal will be reassessed.
