

## ***Drivers Entry Rules***

- A) Each driver must fill out an entry blank.**
- B) Drivers must be 18 years of age** and have a valid driver's permit in their possession. However at the age of 16, with a notarized parental medical statement obtained from Stoney Roberts Headquarters, will be permitted also! Call 443-309-9065 to obtain proper paperwork.
- C) All drivers and cars must be at the track 2 hours before the scheduled starting time of the event.**
- D) All rules and regulations must be observed.** Promoter or track operators reserve the right to approve or reject any or all entries.
- E) Participants are required to sign a release** and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement before entering any restricted area.
- F) Only driver and one mechanic will be permitted in the pit area** or on the track! Arm bands for driver and mechanic will be issued by Stoney Roberts personal and must be displayed at all times. **No one under 16 years of age is allowed in pit area.**
- G) The entry fee** must be cash, money order, or company check. No personal checks. If you wait until the day of events to enter, you will be required to pay a \$10.00 late fee. Enter early to avoid the late payment penalty.
- H) Driver and or mechanic** must be present when vehicle is being inspected. Also driver and mechanic must be at driver meeting that is held before event starts.
- I) All drivers must supply their own vehicles.** You are limited to two cars per session, only exception is specialty events, one per class of the special heats, trucks, minivans, suvs.
- J) Members of the auto demolition derby:** are not employees of the track operators or the promoter of the demolition derby. **No alcoholic beverages** are allowed in or around the pit areas. **Driver or pit crew caught drinking disqualifies their car and driver.**
- K) Additional safety regulations** May be imposed depending on the track. Rules are subject to change to fit event. If you have any safety concerns. Call (443)309-9065. Just because it is not stated in the rules does not make it allowable. If you have Doubts or Questions, call. **Any driver not obeying the RULES will be DISQUALIFIED.**
