The board can look at planning some kind of entertainment for 2 days and bring in a couple of food vendors. The target dates are August 29 and 30.

Bill had talked to Jeanie and Keith about starting fundraising for the grandstand project. He suggested forming a committee to work on the project. Mark will call Kristi Wilfahrt about working on the project. Terry will call Tom Ford to facilitate working with Jay Kleven on the repair project. Mark forwarded an email to the board from Tom Ford for a current grandstand repair project that will need to be done this fall.
