2. Entry clerks will receive exhibits at the commercial exhibitors building at the fairgrounds Tuesday, June ~~25th 20~~^{#21st2nd} between ~~34~~:30 p.m. and ~~87~~:30 p.m.
3. Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor. All entries must be clean, and in good condition for display. All exhibits must have been completed since July ~~201420167.0212020~~
4. Should any exhibits be entered in the wrong class the superintendent may make proper corrections to the exhibit entry.
5. Exhibitors may **make enter** more than one entry in each class. Limit of 3 per lot.
6. If it be ascertained that an exhibitor has made any false statement in regard to any article or exhibitor, if any exhibitor shall attempt to harass or interfere with the judge or judges in the performance of their duties, the exhibitor shall be excluded from competition and forfeit all premiums.
7. All premium money will be paid from the awards as marked by the judges and not from ribbons that may be attached to the exhibits. Judges are instructed not to award a premium or premiums unless article(s) is/are deemed worthy.
