Rules & Premium Information:

1. Entries will not be accepted after July 6th. All substitutions must be made by that date. Late entries may be accepted with Beef Superintendent and Fair Committee approval.

You will be required to make an account and apply via FairEntry.
3. All animals must be in the barn by 8:00PM on Tuesday, prior to opening day. Animals must remain in place until fair closure unless other arrangements are made, subject to SPECIAL PERMISSION by the Fair Manager and the Department Superintendent.
4. Because of limited barn space, those entries received first will receive the first available stall space. Barn Superintendents reserve the right for discretion.
5. 4-H and FFA exhibitors will be allowed to enter their animals in open class, and will be entitled to premium moneys. Appropriate stall fees must be paid by all exhibitors.
6. No exhibitor may receive more than two premium payments in any one class.
7. Exhibitors are required to perform herdsmanhip duties. Exhibitors will be responsible for the entire care of their animals. Cooperative efforts in care and cleaning on barns is expected.
8. All animals on display at the Grays Harbor County Fair must be entered in their correct Section and Class AND WILL BE subject to a Veterinary Inspection prior to entering barn, unless special permission is given by Barn Superintendent.
9. In order to make the show run smoothly, classes will not be held an unreasonable length of time for late entries. The judge may excuse and/or exclude these animals from the judging ring.
10. Feed and supplies may be delivered to the barn before 9:00AM. There will be no moving vehicles on the fairgrounds at any other times during the fair.
11. All ribbons and awards won must be put on display.
12. For health requirements and official rules and regulations, please refer to general rules.
13. Any bull over nine months of age must have a permanent or removable nose ring.
14. Steers entered in Open Class must be of a recognized beef breed. (No dairy crosses will be allowed.) Steers exhibited in Open Class will not be offered in the Youth Livestock Auction.
15. Mileage and Multiple Animal Incentives: *Any Open Class Beef Exhibitor who transports their animals a distance greater than 50 miles will be paid a Mileage Incentive of \$50.00. Any distance over 150 miles will be paid a mileage incentive of \$100. In addition, any Open Class Beef Exhibitor who brings more than three (3) animals to the fair for all four (4) days of the fair will be paid a Multiple Animal Incentive of \$50.00.*

Premium Awards:

1st - 160 points 2nd - 120 points 3rd - 80 points

Special Ribbon Awards:

Rosettes will be awarded to Division and Reserve Division Champions as well as Grand and Reserve Grand Champions. **Rosettes are not paid placings.*

1. COW/CALF PAIR, calf must be shown in individual classes
2. JR HEIFER CALF, born after March 1, current year
3. SR HEIFER CALF, born between September 1, and November 30, previous year
4. SUMMER YEARLING HEIFER, born between May 1 and August 31, previous year
5. LATE JUNIOR YEARLING HEIFER, born between March 1 and April 30, previous year
6. EARLY JUNIOR YEARLING HEIFER, born between January 1, and last day of February, previous year
7. SENIOR YEARLING HEIFER, born between September 1 and December 31, two years previous
8. BRED TWO-YEAR-OLD FEMALE, born between May 1 and August 31, two years previous
9. BRED THREE-YEAR-OLD FEMALE, born between May 1 and August 31, three years previous
10. JR BULL CALF, born after January 1, current year
11. SR BULL CALF, born between September 1 and December 31, previous year
12. SUMMER YEARLING BULL, born between May 1, and August 31, previous year
13. JUNIOR BULL, born between January 1 and April 30, previous year
14. SENIOR BULL, born between January 1 and December 31, two years previous
15. GET OF SIRE, Three head required
16. PAIR OF HEIFERS, owned by exhibitor
17. BEST THREE HEAD, owned by exhibitor
18. FEEDER STEERS, under 1000 pounds
19. MARKET STEERS, over 1000 pounds
