Rules & Information:

1. Registration begins Monday and Tuesday, prior to the Fair, Noon – 6PM.
2. All exhibitors must enter the grounds through the designated gate and park in designated areas.
3. Safety is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Operating equipment must be roped off from the public.
4. Exhibits must be in place by 9:30AM on the day the item is exhibited and must remain in place until the fair closes on that day.
5. Exhibitors will earn 25% of the premium points listed for each day the exhibit is displayed. In lieu of premium checks for the exhibitors, premium points earned will be exchanged for 2 season gate passes.
