OUR MISSION & EVENT HISTORY

Our Mission:

To celebrate our nation's independence, preserve our western heritage, and strengthen our community.

Event History:

The Greeley Stampede is a non-profit 501c4 organization that is rich in tradition and heritage dating back to the late 1800's. It began as a community celebration to honor local potato farmers and has since grown into an internationally acclaimed festival attracting over 210,000 people annually from all parts of the United States and many foreign countries.

Officially named the Greeley Spud Rodeo in 1922, the event featured bucking bronc riding, fancy roping, a pie eating contest, a horse race, motorcycle and bicycle races, and a two-mile Model T Ford "free for all" race. Estimated attendance in that first official festival was 2,500 people.

In an effort to give the event some national recognition, the Greeley Spud Rodeo era ended and, thus, began the age of the "Go West with Greeley" Rodeo. The name was taken from the famous phrase by the city's name sake, Horace Greeley, who said "Go west young man. Go west."

The Greeley Independence Stampede name came in 1972 by means of a community contest and featured professional rodeos, country concerts, July 4th parade, and carnival midway, mixed with food and fun galore!

Today, the event is Colorado's premier summer western celebration. The 2024 event marks the 102nd annual Greeley Stampede that will feature 13 days of affordable family entertainment including rodeo, music, parades, shopping, festival food and fireworks.

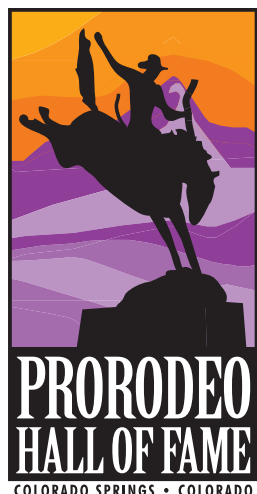

Island Grove Park Improvements

The Greeley Stampede provides park improvements to Island Grove Regional Park as part of our agreement with the City of Greeley.

In 2023, the major projects were the finishing the arena JBS Stage, new arena directional signage, and installing fiber throughout the arena.. Total park improvements for 2023 was **\$335,203**

\$23 million Economic Impact

In 2022, the Greeley Stampede hired the International Festival & Events Association to conduct an economic impact study which was completed by JS&A Economic Development Consulting. This is the first official study completed since 2010 to determine the impact the Greeley Stampede event has on the economy of Greeley. The study found the total revenue generated by the Stampede as thte event and in the City of Greeley to be **\$23 million**.

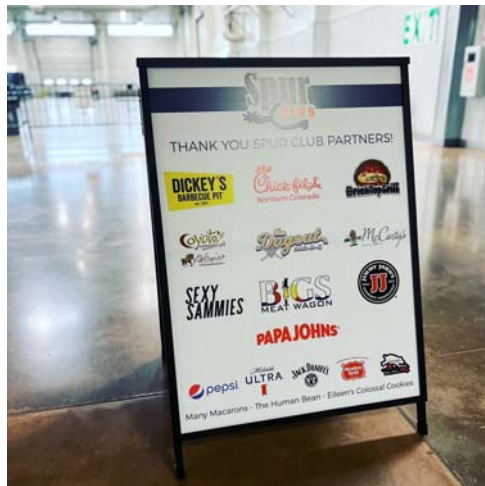

The popular sponsor hospitality area, located northwest of the Stampede Arena, offers complimentary beverages, snacks, restrooms and shaded patio seating.

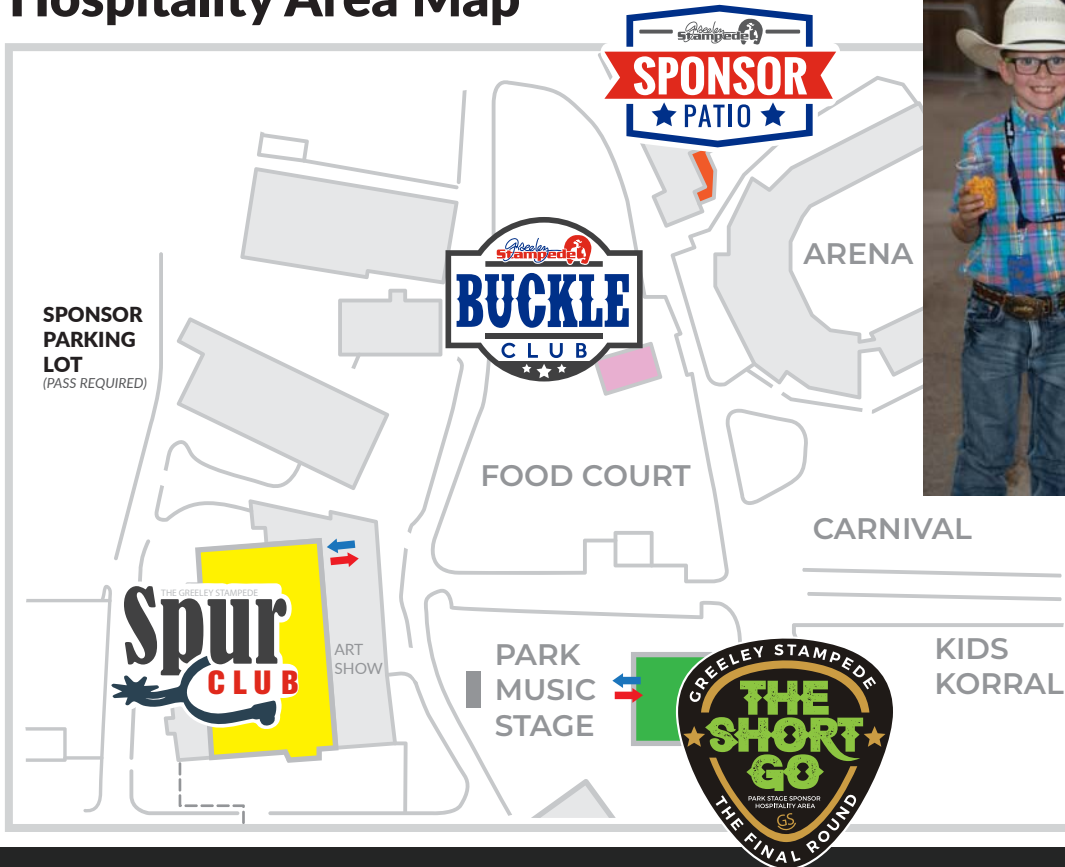
Spur Club

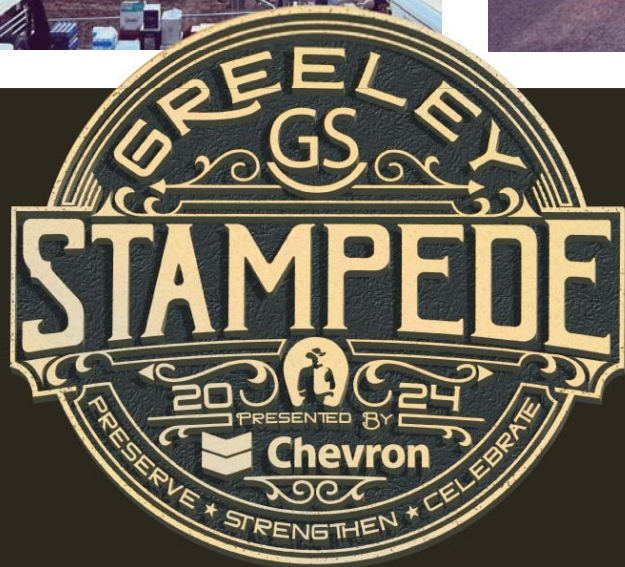
