INTRODUCTION FOR EXHIBITORS

As a Livestock Show Exhibitor, you will have the opportunity to participate in the freezer sale, showcasing the hard work you've invested in raising your market projects. The sale is designed to give you a platform to sell your livestock, which is market-ready for consumers looking to purchase high-quality, locally raised meat. You may sell your steers, swine, lambs, goats, turkey, broilers (qty 3), or market rabbits (pen of 3). If you placed in the show and received a premium award, you still may enter the freezer sale.

There are important mandatory rules associated with the freezer sale. It is highly recommended that prior to entering the freezer sale that you consult with a parent and/or ag teacher. Once you enter the freezer sale and you check in at the fair, the animal(s) will be posted live on the website, and you cannot be removed from the sale for ANY reason. Please read all the rules posted within the Place My Animal in the Sale Form (copied below) and also refer to the Livestock General Rules and Handbook located on the Livestock Page. We highly recommend advertising and trying to find buyers. We have more exhibitors than buyers! Please advertise and share your photo and information on how to purchase your animal on social media. Please share the Harris County Fair and Rodeo's Facebook posts to help advertise the sale and your project!

FREEZER SALE RULES for EXHIBITORS

- Once an exhibitor checks into the fair and submits their project to the Harris County Fair and Rodeo's Freezer Sale, the project CANNOT be pulled out of the sale for any reason.
- If an exhibitor has a buyer committed to purchasing their project, they must direct the buyer to the BUYER'S PURCHASE FORM on our website and inform the buyer when and how to purchase.
- Market Rabbits, Broilers, and Turkey Hens (Only) must be processed and delivered by the exhibitors to the buyer.
- Exhibitors are not required to put their projects on the trailers, but the Freezer Sale Coordinators ask that exhibitors leave one feeding for Sunday morning on Saturday evening by 7:00 p.m.
- If your project isn't purchased by individual buyer(s) at the freezer sale, exhibitors have the option to have it processed and sold for market value. This must be marked on your exhibitor entry form.
- All exhibitors must submit a "Thank you" card to the Freezer Sale table to have your animal visible on the website. If you submitted your project before the fair, the thank you card must be turned in by October 23 by 7pm or your animal will not be live on the Website. Thank you, cards MUST have an envelope with your name, in the return address location or we will not know whose card it is. The location for the buyer's address must be blank.
- If your animal is sold, your animals will no longer be listed on the website.

FORM TO ENTER THE FREEZER SALE

The **Enter the Freeze Sale Form** on the Website and provided below must be completed at a computer (not a mobile device) to be able to upload the photo. It is strongly advised that this form be completed with a parent or discussed with the parent prior to completing. The form **MUST** be completed on a computer versus mobile device to be able to upload the photo. Exhibitors will be able to enter the freezer sale after Oct 23rd check-in using a mobile device when we make providing the photo optional.

INFORMATION NEEDED TO ENTER THE SALE:

3 pieces of Information needed BEFORE submitting the form to enter the freezer sale are listed in the below image.

1. **Landscaped Photo** saved as a jpg formatted file < 5 MB
2. **Title:** First and last name, school/area, year or age - <50 characters
(Note: we modify this title to add check-in weight to your title after check-in, this is why we need you to stop by the freezer sale table after check-in with your thank you card and check-in weight (if applicable). Weight is not needed for small animals.
3. **Description:** Using less than 275 characters to sell yourself and your animal to potential buyers and **MUST** include estimated weight at show.

Your submitted information will be in a Species photo album for Buyers to look through to pick which animal they want to purchase. Your animal will also be listed in the buyer's purchase form to select to buy.

1. Select a LANDSCAPED photo of you and your project that is less than 5 Megs in size and a JPG file.
MUST: Landscape, jpg, <5 MB

2. List a title: Name, School/area, Year or age
MUST: Start with your first and last name and be less than 50 characters

3. Provide a Description
MUST: Include the estimated weight of your animal at check-in (for large animals) and be less than 275 characters.
