Indiana State Fair draws more than 900,000 fairgoers

Indiana State Fairgrounds & Event Center, INDIANAPOLIS, IN, 8/20/17 – The 2017 Indiana State Fair themed "The Wonderful World of Food" welcomed a total of 906,732 fairgoers through its gates over a 17-day run, August 4th-20th, which marks a 24% increase in attendance over 2016. With 17 days of fantastic weather, the fair had steady crowds that enjoyed new attractions, a wide variety of food, and free entertainment.
