Mayor Joe Hogsett Announces 2021 Mayor's Bike to the Fair Day

Free annual event to return August 7

INDIANAPOLIS – Today Mayor Joe Hogsett announced the details of the 2021 Mayor's Bike to the Fair Day, in partnership with the Indiana State Fair. The Indiana State Fair returns this year July 30-August 22, closed Mondays and Tuesdays.

"We're excited to bring back one of our favorite annual events," said Mayor Joe Hogsett. "The Mayor's Bike to the Fair Day is a great way for cyclists of all ages to experience our beautiful trails and greenways on the way to enjoying the unparalleled entertainment of the Indiana State Fair."

The approximately three-mile ride will launch from Barton Park, 2344 N Capitol Avenue, at 10 a.m. on Saturday, August 7. It will follow the Fall Creek Greenway and Monon Trail, showcasing the new Monon Trail bridge above 38th Street, which opened in March.

Individuals and families can participate in the Mayor's Bike to the Fair Day at no charge and will have access to State Fair tickets upon arrival (one per rider). Participants may park at free secured bicycle racks located along the Monon Trail and enter through Gate 18. The racks are available Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. or until 11 p.m. on Thursdays and Saturdays.

ABOUT PEDAL & PARK (Free Bicycle Parking)

Save \$1 off Fair admission when you ride your bicycle to the State Fair and use one of the (free) secured bicycle racks available on the Monon Trail at 38th Street and the NEW location at Fall Creek Parkway and 39th Street. Available Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays from 10 AM to 9 PM, or Thursdays and Saturdays from 10 AM to 11 PM. Bicyclists must enter through Gate 18 on the Monon Trail.

ABOUT THE INDIANA STATE FAIR

The Indiana State Fair is the state's largest multi-day event celebrating Hoosiers' spirit and agricultural heritage. These 18 days celebrate Indiana agriculture and promote it to hundreds of thousands of people across Indiana, and beyond. Nationally recognized for offering great entertainment, showcasing 4-H youth, interactive agriculture education programs, premier facilities and a variety of unique, fun foods, the Indiana State Fair has been an annual attraction for generations of Hoosiers since 1852. The 2021 Indiana State Fair will be held July 30-August 22 (Closed Mondays and Tuesdays). The theme for this year's fair is Celebrating the Hoosier Spirit.

Tickets purchased online before 11:59 PM on July 29 are only \$10 plus convenience fee, while general admission tickets purchased at the gate during the Fair are \$13.
