Thank you for your interest in becoming a part of the construction team for the Indiana State Fairgrounds Fall Creek Pavilion Renovation. Turner + Zurbuch will serve as the Construction Manager and looks forward to receiving bids from prequalified trade partners.

The Indiana State Fair Commission will renovate the swine barn into a multipurpose facility. The building will be renamed the Fall Creek Pavilion. It also will be climate-controlled, accessible and built specifically for livestock use. The age of the building, challenges with loading livestock and a lack of accessibility to those with disabilities are reasons for the renovation.

The work will begin after the 2020 Indiana State Fair and will be substantially complete for the 2021 Fair.

- Schedule is paramount. The Fall Creek Pavilion must be open for the 2021 Indiana State Fair.
- All prime trade partners must be pregualified to bid. Submit pregualification at: https://tinyurl.com/FCPPregualify02
- The Indiana State Fair Commission and Turner + Zurbuch are committed to diversity. This project has a goal of 25% MBE, WBE, and/or VBE participation. All contractors must make a strong effort to meet this goal. Companies must have State of Indiana MBE, WBE and/or VBE credentialing to apply toward the 25% goal.
- Indiana State Fair Commission will make payment to the Construction Manager 30 days post receipt of approved billing.
- Turner offers an Accelerated Payment Program (APP) which provides trade partners the opportunity to receive payment within five days after their Textura pay application is approved, thereby improving cash flow and strengthening balance sheets.
- All billings will be submitted through Textura.
- This project utilizes a Contractor Controlled Insurance Program (CCIP).
- All supervisory personnel will be required to have an OSHA 30 certification.
- Each prime trade partner shall provide a bond for their scope of work.
- All personnel must have a current and verifiable CCS card or equivalent.
- Trade Partners shall fully comply with all E-Verify requirements set forth in Ind. Code 22-5-1.7.

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
