Indiana State Fair Farmers Care food drive results announced Hoosiers helping Hoosiers

INDIANAPOLIS, IN – Hoosiers helping those in need is part of Indiana's culture, and an effort led by the Indiana State Fair has prompted 32 counties to participate in the "Farmers Care" food drives. Through a partnership with the Indiana Association of Fairs (INAF) and Feeding Indiana's Hungry (FISH), these 32 counties have helped Farmers Care collect just over \$26,880 and 43,701 pounds of food. The top five county food drives have been determined by the amount of food they collected:

- 1. Porter County raised \$22,450
- 2. Miami County collected 11,050 pounds of food
- 3. Washington County Farmers Merchants collected 5,862 pounds of food
- 4. Newton County collected 3,920 pounds of food
- 5. Tipton County collected 3,324 pounds of food

The other participating counties include: Adams, Allen, Boone, Clay, Clinton, Daviess, Fayette, Grant, Hamilton, Hancock, Harrison, Hendricks, Howard, Huntington, Jasper, Orange, Perry, Pulaski, Randolph, Shelby, Spencer, Vanderburgh, Vermillion, Wabash, Washington, and Wells.

Leaders in these counties worked with local food banks to secure donations during their county fairs that benefit local hunger relief efforts. Participants of Farmers Care received an allotment of Indiana State Fair tickets to help incentivize donations at the food drives.
