Two Hemispheres Circus Bandwagon Arrives at the Fairgrounds in Preparation

for the Indiana State Fair

What: The Two Hemispheres circus bandwagon has arrived at the Indiana State Fairgrounds & Event Center and will be featured as part of the Indiana State Fair's Celebrating Indiana's Circus history exhibit at the Ball State Harvest Pavilion, August 3-19.

Where: The Two Hemispheres circus bandwagon is on loan from the International Circus Hall of Fame in Peru, IN and has been installed at Ball State Harvest Pavilion located at the Indiana State Fairgrounds & Event Center, 1202 E 38th St., Indianapolis, IN, 46205. In partnership with the Indiana State Museum & Historic Sites, the International Circus Hall of Fame in Peru, IN, plus some of the State Fair's "Celebrating Indiana's Circus," the Circus history exhibit will feature pieces of The Children's Museum of Indianapolis exhibition, "Circus: starring YOU!" This free exhibit is a MUST-SEE at this year's fair.

How: The Two Hemispheres circus bandwagon was used during the Barnum & Bailey's street parades from 1903-1918 and later in the 1936-1938 in the Cole Brothers Circus, Rochester IN. It is nearly 30 feet long, weighs 13,000 pounds and is 116 years-old. During its heyday, it was transported by 40 horses. Today it is the largest circus bandwagon in existence. It was originally built in the winter of 1902 or 1903 by the Sebastian Wagon Co.
