New World Record Set at Prairie Farms World's Ice Cream Eating Championship at the Indiana State Fair

Miki Sudo of Las Vegas downs an astounding 16 pints of ice cream in six minutes to set new Ice Cream Eating World Record; wins \$2,000 in prize money

Indianapolis, IN, 8/13/17 —A new world record was set today in front of a group of enthusiastic fairgoers when the world's top competitive eaters gathered in Indianapolis for the first-ever Prairie Farms Worlds Ice Cream Eating Championship at the Indiana State Fair. Miki Sudo, a top-ranked competitive eater from Las Vegas, NV, set a new world record by downing an astounding 16 pints of ice cream in six minutes. Sudo received \$2,000 of the total \$4,000 Championship purse.

The previous Ice Cream Eating World Record was 15 pints of vanilla ice cream in 6 minutes and was held by Joey Chestnut, a well-known competitive eater who is currently ranked first in the world by Major League Eating. Today's second-place finisher, Juan Rodriguez of Crestwood, IL, consumed a whopping 15 pints of ice cream to match the former record.

As part of its "Wonderful World of Food" theme, the Indiana State Fair is celebrating a different food item during its 17-day run. Today's fair theme celebrated ice cream and the Indiana Dairy Farmer. This year, Major League Eating added the Prairie Farms World Ice Cream Eating Championship at the Indiana State Fair to its 2017 slate of sanctioned championships.
