Contest Rules:

- 1. F.F.A. Chapters or 4-H Clubs must turn in registration to the Fair Office by mail, email, or hand deliver it by October 2nd, 2023. Participation will be limited to the first 10 clubs/chapters registered.
- 2. If you do not turn in an entry form you cannot participate. It is not fair to the other chapters/clubs that got their entries turned in on time.
- 3. All entries must submit a sketch/diagram of decoration drawn in ink. All entries must promote the Jacksonville Fair theme <u>"Ticket to Fun</u>. The sketch/diagram must clearly outline the decoration of the pallet.
- 4. Pallets can be placed lying on their side or standing on end. Specify the position of the pallet placement on your sketch. You will have a limited area in which to work. Restrict your design to your pallet's immediate area so as not to interfere with your neighbor's areas.
- 5. The pallets approximate measurements are 47' L by 40' W.
- 6. Clubs/Chapters will be notified by email if they have been selected to participate by October 4th, 2023.
- 7. The Jacksonville Fair Association will provide **two** pallets for each participating Club/Chapter to decorate. If you plan to provide and use additional pallets (maximum 3 pallets total) for feet or decoration, please list in your sketch/diagram plans. For safety purposes, pallets will NOT be stacked on top of each other.

- 8. Entries will be judged on eye appeal, construction, creativity, use of materials and the fair theme.
- 9. The Jacksonville Fair Association will place the pallets on and around the fairgrounds. Please check in at the Fair Office (510 Fairgrounds Place) for your assigned space. You can decorate the pallets on Sunday, October 29th after 2:00 p.m., or from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 30th, and Tuesday and Wednesday, October 31st and November 1st from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
- 10. All decorating must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on November 1st, 2023.
- **11**. Entries will be judged on Thursday, November 2nd, 2023. Winners will be announced during the Hamburger Bash, which takes place on Saturday, November 4th at 5:30 p.m.
- 12. The pallets should be decorated with a good, clean, wholesome nature. No vulgar or suggestive decorations will be allowed.
- 13. NO Commercial or Political signs of ANY KIND are allowed.
- 14. Decorations should be weather and wind –proof. Paint may be applied to the pallet.
- 15. It is the responsibility of each Club/Chapter to remove its decorations after the fair. Clean up may begin on Monday, November 13th at 9:00 a.m. Decorations not removed by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 14th, 2022 will be discarded. The Fair Association is not responsible for any decorations!
- **16**. All members of the Clubs/Chapters MUST be students. Parents should not be doing the decorating for them.
