## OCTOBER 1ST IS THE DEADLINE FOR LIVESTOCK ENTRIES

**ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** You will register online. Complete the entry form and pay online. Please also bring your cattle's registration papers with you to the fair. They will be examined when you check-in at the Jacksonville Fair.

**NOTICE:** In the case of papers pending, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide the Jacksonville Fair with a letter from the breed association stating that the papers on the animal have been applied for but have not yet been processed. Papers pending will not be accepted without this letter from the association.

**PARKING:** Exhibitors participating in the Open and Youth Cattle Shows will be given parking passes for the Exhibitor Lot. Parking Lot # 2 is reserved for 11-day exhibitors, admission control, Fair Board Members, staff, security, Jacksonville Sheriff Officers, and for Fire and Rescue Trucks that may be needed for any emergency that may arise during the Jacksonville Fair. This lot will be monitored to assure that it is not used by anyone except those previously listed and who have a Parking Lot # 2 Pass hanging on their rearview mirror with the correct name. This will be strictly enforced.

### **PASSES:**

Gate passes will be issued on the following basis. 1-6 animals, six (6) daily admission tickets and three one day Exhibitor Lot parking passes, 7-12 animals, nine (9) daily admission tickets and six one day Exhibitor Lot parking passes, 13 and over animals, twelve (12) daily admission tickets and six one day Exhibitor Lot parking passes.

Please note: All passes will be single daily admission tickets. All parking passes for Open and Youth Shows will be for the Exhibitor Lot. (11-day exhibitors get one Lot 2 pass and one Exhibitor Lot pass.) No additional parking or admission passes will be given if showing in the Youth Show as well.

Separate shows will be held for each breed with a minimum of 10 head per breed or 3 exhibitors.

## **AMERICAN BRAHMAN BREEDERS ASSOCIATION ABBA OFFICIAL SHOW RULES**

EFFECTIVE JUNE 9, 2023

The American Brahman Breeders Association ("ABBA") reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these ABBA Official Show Rules and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, arising therefrom or otherwise connected with or incident thereto, and the right to amend or expand these ABBA Official Show Rules as the ABBA may determine, from

time to time. Any violation hereof shall be punishable in such manner as the ABBA shall deem appropriate under the circumstances in the sole discretion of the ABBA.

The ABBA Official Show Rules set forth herein shall fully replace, supplant and supersede the prior Rules & Procedures Governing the Showing and Exhibiting of Registered Brahman Cattle as previously adopted and published by the ABBA. In the event a matter or circumstance provided for in the ABBA Official Show Rules set forth herein shall conflict with any other rules of the ABBA (save for the ABBA Constitution only), including, but not limited to, the ABBA Show Ring Code of Conduct and Ethics, then the ABBA Official Show Rules set forth herein shall govern.

## DEFINITIONS

A. ABBA shall mean and include the American Brahman Breeders Association as operated and governed by and through its Officers and Directors pursuant to the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

B. ABBA Member shall mean and include individuals or entities defined by the same or similar term in the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

C. ABBA Board of Directors shall mean and include the group of individuals defined by the same or similar term in the ABBA Constitution who serve as ABBA leadership pursuant to the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

D. ABBA Executive Committee shall mean and include the group of individuals defined by the same or similar term in the ABBA Constitution who are selected as ABBA executive leadership by the ABBA Board of Directors pursuant to ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

E. ABBA Show Committee shall mean and include the group of individuals defined by the same or similar term in the ABBA Constitution who are appointed by the ABBA President pursuant to the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

F. ABBA Register of Renown shall mean and include the Brahman Register of Renown as the term used in the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

G. ABBA Register of Renown Points shall mean and include the points awarded Animals based on the placings of progeny of such Animals competing at Shows approved by the ABBA pursuant to the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules.

H. ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook shall mean and include the official registry for Brahman Animals as established by the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules and maintained by the ABBA.

I. ABBA Approved Show or ABBA Approved Point Show shall mean and include any livestock event in which Brahman cattle registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook are exhibited and which has been designated by the ABBA as approved to accumulate points for the ABBA Register of Renown.

J. ABBA Sponsored Show shall mean and include any ABBA Approved Show at which has been officially so designated by the ABBA as an ABBA Sponsored Show. This shall specifically include the two shows commonly known as the National Brahman Show and the International Brahman Show as well as any other Show officially so designated by formal action of the ABBA.

K. ABBA Sanctioned Show shall mean and include any ABBA Approved Show which has NOT been officially designated by the ABBA as an ABBA Sponsored Show.

L. Breeder shall mean and include the person(s) or entity(ies) shown as the “Breeder” of an Animal as printed on the Animal’s most recently issued ABBA registration certificate and as also identified as such in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook.

M. Owner shall mean and include the person(s) or entity(ies) shown as the “Owner” or “Present Owner” of an Animal as printed on the Animal’s most recently issued ABBA registration certificate and as also identified as such in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook.

N. Exhibitor shall mean and include the person(s) or entity(ies) under who’s name or identity the official entry of an Animal at an ABBA Approved Show is made.

O. Showman shall mean and include the person(s) who physically exhibits an Animal in the Show Ring at an ABBA Approved Show.

P. Fitter shall mean and include the person(s) who is involved with the care, maintenance and show preparation of an Animal at any time during an ABBA Approved Show.

Q. ABBA Show Year shall mean and include the annual time period during which ABBA Approved Shows may occur and in which ABBA Register of Renown Points may be awarded. The ABBA Show Year shall begin each calendar year on July 1 and end on June 30 of the following calendar year. The ABBA Show Year shall be divided into two (2) Show Seasons (as defined below).

R. ABBA Fall Show Season shall mean and include the period of time over which ABBA Approved Shows occur between July 1 and December 31 of a calendar year.

S. ABBA Spring Show Season shall mean and include the period of time over which ABBA Approved Shows occur between January 1 and June 30 of a calendar year.

T. ABBA Official Show Classes shall mean and include the classes and divisions, as established by the ABBA from time to time, for the exhibition of registered Brahman Animals at an ABBA Approved Show. The ABBA shall establish separate ABBA Official Show Classes for Fall Shows (occurring between July 1 and December 31) and for Spring Shows (occurring between January 1 and June 30). The ABBA Official Show Classes shall specifically be deemed to include the Official Show Class Conditions (defined below).

U. ABBA Official Show Class Conditions shall mean and include certain requirements or limitations relating to exhibiting Animals within ABBA Official Show Classes at ABBA Approved Shows.

V. Official Show Results shall mean and include the official class and division placings of Animals participating in an ABBA Approved Show as provided to the ABBA by Show Management of such ABBA Approved Show.

W. ABBA Color Classification Committee shall mean and include the Special Committee appointed, from time to time, by the ABBA to conduct color classification at designated ABBA Approved Shows for Animals which require color classification to be exhibited at ABBA Approved Shows.

X. ABBA Color Classification Rules shall mean and include the specific rules and guidelines established by the ABBA, from time to time, concerning the color classification standards for certain Animals being registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and exhibited at ABBA Approved Shows.

Y. ABBA Official Color Classification Chart shall mean and include the visual chart illustrating examples of Animals of acceptable color to meet color classification standards for certain Animals being registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and exhibited at ABBA Approved Shows.

Z. ABBA DNA Verification Rules shall mean and include the specific rules and guidelines established by the ABBA, from time to time, concerning the DNA verification standards of certain Animals being registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and exhibited at ABBA Approved Shows.

Terms not specifically defined herein shall be given the meaning of such same or similar term in the ABBA Constitution and its accompanying ABBA Rules, and if not defined therein, then the meaning most generally associated with such term in the Brahman breed/livestock industry or in connection with the exhibition of Brahman Animals/livestock.

## ABBA APPROVED SHOWS

The ABBA shall upon written request designate as an ABBA Approved Show certain Livestock Shows or Events in which Brahman cattle that are registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook are exhibited. ABBA Register of Renown Points may be accumulated at ABBA Approved Shows.

An ABBA Approved Show shall be categorized by the ABBA as either [1] an ABBA Sponsored Show, or [2] an ABBA Sanctioned Show.

An ABBA Sponsored Show is an ABBA Approved Show which has been officially so designated by the ABBA as an ABBA Sponsored Show.

An ABBA Sanctioned Show is any ABBA Approved Show which has NOT been officially designated by the ABBA as an ABBA Sponsored Show.

All ABBA Approved Shows shall be governed by and subject to the ABBA Official Show Rules established hereby. ABBA Sponsored Shows shall further be governed by and subject to the ABBA Sponsored Show Conditions set out herein. ABBA Sanctioned Shows shall further be governed by and subject to the ABBA Sanctioned Show Conditions set out herein.

The ABBA (including all Directors, Officers, Members, employees or other authorized agents of the ABBA) shall in no case be responsible or liable for any loss or damage that may be incurred relating to participation in or attendance at an ABBA Approved Show. Each Participant or Guest at an ABBA Approved Show shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage done to, occasioned by, or arising from participation in or attendance at an ABBA Approved Show. Participants and Guests shall indemnify the ABBA against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto, as well as damage or injury to any other person, animal or property caused by a Participant or Guest or arising out of, or in any way connected with an ABBA Approved Show. All persons who attend an ABBA Approved Show do so at their own risk and the ABBA assumes no liability, legal or otherwise, for any loss, damage, accident or other occurrence.

## PRIVILEGES

Designation as an ABBA Approved Show is a privilege, not a right, bestowed by the American Brahman Breeders Association upon Shows so designated by the ABBA. This privilege shall be open to individuals and entities deemed suitable by the ABBA to fairly and positively represent the Brahman breed of Animals in the livestock industry, particularly in the exhibition thereof at ABBA Approved Shows. The ABBA shall have the unrestricted right to revoke such privilege at any time upon proper notice.

Participating in an ABBA Approved show as an ABBA Member, Breeder, Owner, Exhibitor, Showman or Fitter is a privilege, not a right, bestowed by the American Brahman Breeders Association and/or Show Management of an ABBA Approved Show upon such ABBA Member, Breeder, Owner, Exhibitor, Showman or Fitter. This privilege shall be open to individuals and entities deemed suitable by the ABBA and/or Show Management of an ABBA Approved Show to fairly and positively represent the Brahman breed of Animals in the livestock industry, particularly in the exhibition thereof at ABBA Approved Shows. The ABBA and/or Show Management of an ABBA Approved Show shall have the unrestricted right to revoke such privilege at any time upon proper notice.

## **ABBA COLOR CLASSIFICATION RULES**

All Animals exhibited at any ABBA Approved Show shall be subject to the following ABBA Color Classification Rules:

A. The applicable Official ABBA Color Chart, as updated and published from time to time by the ABBA, shall serve as the official breed resource for identifying and determining the proper hair coat color of an Animal to be registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook as a Red Brahman Animal (the current Official ABBA Color Chart is available from the ABBA).

B. To be eligible to be exhibited at an ABBA Approved Show as a Red Brahman, an Animal must be registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook as a Red Brahman and have a minimum of four (4) out of the fourteen (14) ancestors in their 3-generation pedigree which are registered as a Red Brahman in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook, subject to the following conditions:

[1] An Animal registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook as a Red Brahman which has at least seven (7) out of the fourteen (14) ancestors in their 3-generation pedigree which ancestors are registered as Red Brahman in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook may be exhibited at an ABBA Approved Show prior to having been color classified as a Red Brahman Animal by the ABBA Color Classification Committee; provided, the Animal shall be subject to color classification by the ABBA Color Classification Committee at the first ABBA Approved Show in which the Animal is exhibited and the ABBA Color Classification Committee conducts color classification. An Animal which has previously been exhibited as a Red Brahman Animal under this provision, but which upon presentation for color classification by the ABBA Color Classification Committee is determined to not meet the color classification standards to be exhibited as a Red Brahman shall no longer be permitted to continue to be exhibited as a Red Brahman Animal at ABBA Approved Shows. Violations of this provision are subject to disciplinary action at the discretion of the ABBA.

[2] An Animal registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook as a Red Brahman which has at least four (4) but less than seven (7) out of the fourteen (14) ancestors in their 3-generation pedigree which ancestors are registered as Red Brahman in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook may not be exhibited at an ABBA Approved Show prior to having been color classified as a Red Brahman Animal by the ABBA Color Classification Committee. Violations of this provision are subject to disciplinary action at the discretion of the ABBA.

[3] An Animal registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook as either a Red Brahman or a Grey Brahman which has less than four (4) out of the fourteen (14) ancestors in their 3-generation pedigree which ancestors are registered as Red Brahman in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook is ineligible to be exhibited as a Red Brahman Animal at an ABBA Approved Show. Violations of this provision are subject to disciplinary action at the discretion of the ABBA.

C. The ABBA Color Classification Committee shall consist of three (3) primary members and two (2) alternates, appointed according to the ABBA Constitution. The ABBA Color Classification Committee will be appointed by the ABBA and will serve for the full ABBA Show Year (July 1 - June 30).

D. Animals which have not previously been color classified as a Red Brahman must be presented to be classified by the ABBA Color Classification Committee at [1] the ABBA Approved Shows commonly known as the National Brahman Show, the International Brahman Show, the Kick-Off Classic and the Southwestern Livestock Show and Rodeo (a/k/a the Fort Worth Livestock Show), [2] any other ABBA Approved Show as may be determined by the ABBA from time to time, and [3] the AJBA All American Junior National Brahman Show. Additionally, the ABBA reserves the right to color classify Animals being exhibited as a Red Brahman Animal at any ABBA Approved Show unannounced.

E. Upon presentation of an Animal intended to be exhibited at ABBA Approved Shows to the ABBA Color Classification Committee for color classification, an Animal shall be classified by the Committee based on its predominant hair color determined by the Official ABBA Color Chart. If an Animal presented to the ABBA Color Classification Committee is unable to be color classified based upon the Official ABBA Color Chart alone, then the Animal's pedigree may be used by the ABBA Color Classification Committee to aid in color classification.

F. An Animal's original registration certificate issued by the ABBA must be provided at the time of color classification by the ABBA Color Classification Committee. Once color classified as a Red Brahman Animal by the ABBA Color Classification Committee, the Animal's original registration certificate shall be stamped by the ABBA indicating the Animal has been color classified as a Red Brahman; alternatively, if the Animal is not classified by the Committee as a Red Brahman Animal then the Animal shall be deemed a Grey Brahman Animal and shall not be eligible to be re-presented for color classification as a Red Brahman Animal at any subsequent color classification conducted by the ABBA Color Classification Committee. Subject to the right of appeal, the decision of the ABBA Color Classification Committee as set out below, an Animal will remain classified (and shall not be subject to re-classification) as determined by the ABBA Color Classification Committee throughout the Animal's show career.

G. Any appeal of the color classification decision by the ABBA Color Classification Committee for any Animal must be made by the Owner of the Animal to the ABBA in writing within ten (10) days of such color classification.

H. If an Animal which was registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook as a Red Brahman is reclassified as a Grey Brahman by the ABBA Color Classification Committee, the ABBA will make such change in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and provide a corrected registration certificate to the Owner of the Animal with thirty (30) days of such color re-classification.

I. All Animals exhibited in the Get of Sire, Natural Produce of Dam and Embryo Produce of Dam Group Classes at an ABBA Approved Show must be exhibited under the registered color of the represented Sire and/or Dam; NOT the color of the progeny comprising the Group. The Breeders Genetic Group and Breeder's Herd shall be exhibited under the registered color of the individual Animals (which all must be registered with the ABBA as the same color) comprising the Group.

J. Any violation of these ABBA Color Classification Rules shall be punishable in such manner as the ABBA shall deem appropriate under the circumstances in the sole discretion of the ABBA.

# ABBA OFFICIAL FALL SHOW CLASSES

(For ABBA APPROVED SHOWS occurring between July 1 and December 31 each year)

*EFFECTIVE JUNE 9, 2023*

Subject to the immediately following ABBA Official Show Class Special Conditions, Animals exhibited at both Sponsored and Sanctioned American Brahman Breeders Association ("ABBA") Open Shows shall be presented for judging as Grey Brahman and Red Brahman classifications within the Official Classes and Divisions set out herein below:

## **ABBA OFFICIAL SHOW CLASS SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

- A. All Animals exhibited must be registered with the American Brahman Breeders Association ("ABBA") and be appropriately fire branded as provided by ABBA requirements for registration in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook.
- B. All Animals exhibited are subject to the ABBA Color Classification Rules as established from time to time. A copy of the most current ABBA Color Classification Rules may be obtained from the ABBA.
- C. All animals exhibited are subject to the ABBA DNA Verification Rules as established from time to time. A copy of the most current ABBA DNA Verification Rules may be obtained from the ABBA.
- D. All Females exhibited in the Senior Division must either [1] be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy issued by a licensed veterinarian (within 90 days prior to the date of the Show) certifying the Animal is pregnant and such certificate shall be made available for inspection and verification upon request, [2] be in a lactating stage and have her natural, nursing calf at side, which Calf has not exceeded 240 days old as of the date of the Show, or [3] have weaned her natural calf which Calf is registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and the Calf's registration certificate is available for inspection and verification upon request.
- E. All Females exhibited in the Aged Senior Division\* must either [1] be in a lactating stage and have her natural, nursing calf at side which Calf has not exceeded 240 days old as of the date of the Show, or [2] have weaned her natural calf which Calf is registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and the Calf's registration certificate is available for inspection and verification upon request. **\*FOR THE FALL 2023 SHOW SEASON ONLY, FEMALES EXHIBITED IN CLASS 34 LATE AGED SENIOR COWS SHALL BE ALLOWED TO BE EXHIBITED WITHOUT A NATURAL, NURSING CALF AT SIDE PROVIDED THE FEMALE MEETS THE PREGNANCY STATUS REQUIREMENTS OF THE SENIOR DIVISION OF FEMALES.**
- F. All Bulls must be exhibited with a permanent or temporary nose ring with an appropriate lead attached.
- G. All Bulls exhibited in the Senior and Aged Senior Divisions must be accompanied by a valid, satisfactory Breeding Soundness Exam (BSE) certification issued by a licensed veterinarian (within one year prior to the date of the Show) and such certification shall be made available for inspection and verification upon request.



- H. All Animals in the Calf and Junior Yearling Divisions which have been previously disqualified from being exhibited at an ABBA Approved Show based on not meeting Weights and Measures Parameters may not be exhibited at another ABBA Approved Show until such time as [1] the Animal re-qualifies by meeting Weights and Measures Parameters at a subsequent ABBA Approved Show where weights and measures are taken, or [2] the Animal is no longer being exhibited in the Calf or Junior Yearling Divisions at ABBA Approved Shows.
- I. All Group Classes will be exhibited at the beginning of the ABBA Approved Show prior to any individual classes being exhibited in such Show. All individual Animals exhibited in Group Classes must be presented by an individual Showman for each participating Animal for the Group to be placed by the Judge(s).
- J. All Animals exhibited in the Get of Sire, Natural Produce of Dam and Embryo Produce of Dam Group Classes at an ABBA Approved Show must be exhibited under the registered color of the represented Sire or Dam; NOT the color of the progeny comprising the Group. The Breeders Genetic Group and Breeder's Herd shall be exhibited under the registered color of the individual Animals (which all must be registered as the same color) comprising the Group.
- K. All Classes which exceed more than fifteen (15) Animals MAY be broken into smaller Classes each no larger than 15 Animals, at the sole discretion of Show Management, by dividing the Classes as evenly as possible without splitting Animals with the same birth date. Additional Classes resulting from splitting Classes shall be treated as new individual Classes (and not as heats of a single Class) for purposes of class placings, competition within Divisions, and ABBA Register of Renown Points awarded.

## **GROUPS**

**ALL GROUP CLASSES SHALL BE EXHIBITED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE ABBA APPROVED SHOW PRIOR TO ANY INDIVIDUAL CLASSES BEING EXHIBITED.**

- G1. PRODUCE OF DAM - Two (2) natural born Animals both produced by the same Dam, either or both sexes may be represented. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No ownership requirement for the participating individual Animals in the Group. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Dam. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judge(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.
- G2. EMBRYO PRODUCE OF DAM - Two (2) Animals both produced by the same Dam via embryo transfer, either or both sexes may be represented. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No ownership requirement for the participating individual Animals in the Group. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Dam. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judge(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.
- G3. GET OF SIRE - Four (4) Animals all by the same Sire from at least two different Dams, both sexes must be represented. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No ownership requirement for the

participating individual Animals in the Group. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Sire. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judge(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.

- G4. BREEDER'S GENETIC GROUP - Three (3) genetically similar Animals all by the same Sire and same Dam, either or both sexes may be represented. All individual Animals comprising this Group shall be registered with the ABBA as the same color and shall be exhibited based on the color of the individual Animals comprising the Group as registered with the ABBA. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Sire and Dam mating combination. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judges(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.
- G5. BREEDER'S HERD - Four (4) Animals, both sexes must be represented. All individual Animals comprising this Group must have the same (Breeder's) holding brand. All individual Animals comprising this Group shall be registered with the ABBA as the same color and shall be exhibited based on the color of the individual Animals comprising the Group as registered with the ABBA. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. All entries in this Class must be placed

### Release Rule:

Exhibitors will be released by zones. The zone map and release schedule for staggered release will be posted on the Livestock Office Bulletin Board. Consideration will first be given to exhibitors living farthest away within and outside of the State of Florida. No exhibitor will be released without first having their barn and tack areas cleaned, checked, and cleared by the Barn Superintendent who shall issue an all-clear notice. Exhibitor must then give this notice to the Livestock Secretary before beginning to load out.
