TOURISM IMPACT –

The events that are held at the Jefferson County Fair Park throughout the year bring in tourists from approximately 35 States with patrons staying at the Fair Park campground and local hotels. Our guests are interested in learning what to explore during their time in Jefferson County and we are now able to assist them better with the creation of the Jefferson County Visitor's Center in the Activity Center Lobby. The Fair Park logo was painted on the wall as the backdrop for the Visitor' Center. This area features information about Jefferson County businesses and attractions as well as publications from over 50 different areas in Wisconsin. Jefferson County Area Tourism Council (JCATC) members staff this area during events to promote tourism in Jefferson County. The JCATC also utilities the Fair Park for their monthly member meetings.

The Fair Park is a recipient of the Tourism Capital Grant Program through the Department of Administration to assist with facility updates in the Activity Center, camping and vendor utilities, and internet project to be completed by December 2024.

JEFFERSON COUNTY FAIR -

Since 1853, our fair has been known around the country as one of the premier County Fair's in Wisconsin. Our County Fair is also one of the largest animal exhibitions in Wisconsin hosting an average 1,000 animals in 5 days. Approximately 37,000 people attend the fair each year the second weekend in July.

For the past 13 years the Jefferson County Fair has coordinated advertising, sponsors, activities and vendors around a theme that



highlights a segment of the Fair. In 2023, the theme was "Year of the Arts" highlighting the arts and entertainment industry. The Exhibitors displaying their projects in the barns and other buildings did an excellent job of embracing the theme this year. The theme also helped us initiate a new partnership with the Arts Alliance of Greater Jefferson who helped us bring Plein air at the Fair! This new program brought both a competition between artists but also gave the fairgoers entertainment by watching the painters paint live throughout the Fair each day of the Fair. The paintings were then auctioned off and proceeds were split between both organizations to help fund future programs.

Another new feature was an updated area for the Coors Light Entertainment tent to build on courtyard type area in the middle of the Fair.

The 2024 Jefferson County Fair will be held July 10-14th and the theme will be determined and announced this Spring.
